From Your President

Our Fall Schooling Show is scheduled for September 27. This is our last show of the year. We will be at Jen Bolen's Benchmark Farm in Lenoir City. The online entry forms have gone out and are posted on social media. Our schooling shows are wonderful opportunities to try a new dressage test or get a young horse out in a show atmosphere or for a new rider or a rider trying something new. Closing date is September 22, so get your online entries in!

If you want to be eligible for year-end schooling awards, you need to have shown in at least 2 different shows with 2 different judges. The horse/rider combination must submit at least 3 scores from 2 different judges at 2 different shows. At least 1 score must be derived from the highest test of that level.

October 18-19 is our third in a series of clinics with Cathy Zappe. It will again be held at Shannon O'Hatnick's Red Oak Hill Farm in Lenoir City. We appreciate Shannon hosting this event. Both the April and the July clinics were very popular and I'm sure this one will fill up fast. Members can audit for free; nonmembers are only \$10 to audit. The online entry form will be posted by mid-September.

Because of the Cathy Zappe clinic October 18-19, we will NOT be hosting Fall Fun Day this year.

January 31, 6:30 p.m. is the date for our Annual meeting and awards banquet. If you want to be considered for year-end awards, your scores need to be sent in no later than December 3, 2025.

Please volunteer at our Fall Show. If you want to qualify for year-end awards, our rules state you have to have a least 4 hours of volunteer time. We will need help setting up on Thursday, September 25. We need a ring steward, someone to help with parking and folks to help tear down after the show on Saturday. The Connection Course Clinic

August 23-24

Three CDCTS members (Carolyn Ordal, Candi Mindey and Anne Titus) attended the Connection Course Clinic on August 23-24. This was defined as “the horse lover’s guide to listening, relaxing and connecting to their horse.” Taught by Keli Scott, Certified Equine Massage Therapist & Equine Myofascial Release practitioner and owner of Sunrise Equine Therapy. The clinic had both classroom and hands on learning opportunities. She states that “equine massage, in particular, brought into focus the thing she has always loved best about horses, connection.” It’s not just the horse, but it is also about how we, as owners, can be present in the moment to have that deeper connection with our horses.

Held at Sonny Brook Farm in West Knoxville, this group of 4 (4th student was Becke Boque, DVM) had classroom sessions in the event center and then went downstairs to the stable to practice what we had learned on their horses and ponies. We learned about the different muscle groups of the horse and which techniques worked best on each area.

“Equine massage is using hands-on techniques to a horse’s muscles, fascia and other soft tissues. This improves circulation, reduces tension, and enhances range of motion and supports overall physical and emotional well-being.” I know that works for me when I get a massage and end up a “limp noodle “ afterwards! When we practiced the different techniques of effleurage, petrissage, tapotment, and friction, it was very evident which horses liked it and which did not. We could see the subtle shifts in breath, slow blinks and lip twitches of those ponies that were really enjoying it. Just as it was evident that one pony, while not mean or nasty, was not happy with being touched. Anne brought her horse Matteo and while she was the one who worked on him, he did serve as a model when we all touched him. He was a very good boy!

Everyone who attended this clinic enjoyed it and learned a lot. We recommend this clinic when it is offered in the future. Am I an expert equine massage therapist after this clinic? No, but I am a horse owner who now has more tools in my toolbox to increase my connectivity with my horse. If I have better connectivity through massage, that can carry over to my riding.

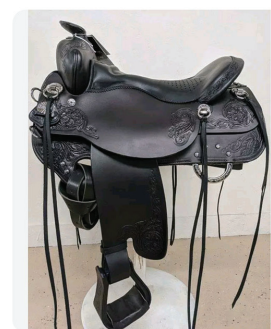
