CDCTS MEETING MINUTES October 10, 2017

I. Call to order

President Susan Price called to order the regular meeting of the CDCTS Board at 6:55 pm on September 12, 2017 at Puleo's at 1260 N Peters Road, (Cedar Bluff Location), Knoxville TN.

II. Roll call

President Susan Price conducted the roll call. The following **Board members** were present: Susan Price, Christina Cardenas, Carol Mitchell, Carolyn Ordal, Mary Sivley, Ashley Phillips, Rita Dunn and Diane Carlson. The following Board members were absent: Melissa McKenzie. There was a quorum. The following **CDCTS members** were in attendance: Christen Kiefer-Lambert, Dave McAdoo, Isabella Cardenas, Jean Sullivan, Susan Hill, Jen Bolin, Pat Sandlin-Bloom, Judy Cornett, Kaylen Moon, Katherine Verdin, Anne Titus, Jeanie Baggett, Caylee Baggett, Julie Noe and Jill Strain. **Visitors:** Kennetha Eikelberg, Jonathan Strain, Sasha Bolen, Jeff Titus, and Charles Sivley.

III. Approval of minutes from last meeting

Minutes from July 11, 2017 meeting and September 12 meeting were sent electronically to all members for their review. A motion to accept the minutes as read was submitted by Christen Kiefer-Lambert and seconded by Jean Sullivan. Carried.

IV. Committee Reports

Treasurer's Report. Treasurer Mary Sivley read the report. Motion to approve by Jeannie Baggett, seconded by Diane Carlson. Approved.

Show Committee.

- a. Fall Schooling Show. Final report provided by the Show Secretary, Carol Mitchell. The show had 33 horse/rider combinations, up in numbers by 10 horse/rider combinations from last fall's show. Gross income from the show: \$2240. Expenses: \$715.26. Total Revenue: \$1524.74. Miscellaneous items: Snacks and drinks gross income: \$19.00. Float had \$60. A payout of \$40 in return of individual bridle tag fees, leaving the float returned with \$20.00
- b. Winter Schooling Show. To be held at Icon Sporthorses, 1201 Disco Loop, Friendsville TN on December 16, 2017. Judge Darlene Dixon-Bottorff, L Graduate, College Grove TN. Volunteers needed for the show are as follows: scribe, scorer, manure management teams (2 teams), concession stand (2-3 people), parking coordinator, cleanup team, trailer transport to ICON from Jen Bolen's property the day prior and return to Jen Bolen's facility at the end of the show.
- c. Spring Schooling Show 2018. To be held on Saturday May 5, 2018. Location: Jean Bolen's Benchmark Farm facility, if her additional rings are completed in time. Judge Debbie Schwartz, contract for judge has been sent.
- d. Fall Schooling Show 2018. Date September 22, 2018. Judge: verbal confirmation of Danielle Perry. Contract to be sent out. Location TBD.

Christina Cardenas, Show Committee Chair, pointed out that she has not been involved in the show planning process over the past year. She requested volunteers to fill the committee positions. The following members volunteered to be on the committee: Anne Titus, Jeannie Baggett, Christen Kiefer-Lambert.

Eventing Clinic/Committee. Ashley Phillips presented her update on the Lucinda Green Clinic, set for Nov 21-22, 2017. Details include costs:

Lucinda's fee is 1800 British Pounds/day (approximately \$2400 USD per day).

Her airfare is TBD as we will share the cost with other clubs who are also coordinating with Lucinda's visit. Last year's cost was approximately \$530 USD

ICON fees: \$15 per horse plus a \$75 fee for use of the lounge/kitchen area

River Glen Fees

-\$50 per horse schooling fee but Ashley is negotiating with the owner of River Glen for a reduction on the fees. CDCTS Volunteer Vouchers can be used to offset schooling fees so riders will write a separate check to River Glen for schooling fee instead of CDCTS writing one large check to cover these fees.

Overall the costs per rider have gone up from last year, due to the increased cost to have the clinic partially at River Glen (\$35 increase) and because Lucinda has raised her daily rate by 50 British Pounds. The overall cost is \$285 for CDCTS members, \$325 non-members, \$20 auditing for CDCTS members, \$30 auditing for non-CDCTS members.

Banquet Committee: Susan Hill and Rita Dunn, coordinators of this event, provided an update. It will be held on Saturday evening, 27 Jan 2018. Location: possibly Buddy's BBQ in Bearden or The Venue, Lenoir City. Susan is looking into costs and benefits of both locations prior to making a decision.

Fun Day/Faux Hunter Pace. Carolyn Ordal, event coordinator, provided an update. Date is October 21, 2017, location River Plains Farm, 1023 Creek Rd, Strawberry Plains, TN. No rain date. Volunteers desperately needed in the following areas (names in brackets have volunteered): set up (Dave McAdoo, Jill Strain +), clean up (Jean Sullivan +), concessions, timers (Carol Grau +), bring trailer day prior and return trailer, course monitors who stay on the course until the jumping starts.

She is sired by European champion dressage stallion Rubignon /Rubinstein / Donnerhall / pik Solo. The dam is Peugeot, a Hanoverian and N.A. Oldenburg approved mare that was Champion at her foal inspection. She was Champion at her inspection for non-Hanoverian mares when being approved for Hanoverian breeding. Peugeot was in training and injured an eye very badly; this injury ended her possible show career. She is sired by Hanoverian stallion Pablito and out of a Thoroughbred mare. Pablito has extensive blood lines for both dressage and jumping. Currently priced at \$12,500.

Wregan Rocks is a 3 year old, bright, flashy chestnut Hanoverian gelding with two white rear stockings and a star and stripe. Wregan is currently doing ground work, and has a great, willing disposition.

He is sired by European champion Grand Prix stallion Wild Dance /VolkensteinII/Matcho. In Germany, his sire won his stallion testing with 147 in Dressage and Rideability and 9's in his jumping ability and has several offspring at the Grand Prix level. The dam is Porscha, an Oldenburg/Hanoverian approved mare. Wregan was Porscha's first foal and she outdid herself with him. He is a beautiful mover as well as a looker. Porscha had a very short show career; during her career she scored in the 70's in her only two shows and won all her classes with Missy Cool riding and training her. She was injured during a pre-purchase exam and became a mom for two years. She is now back in training. Currently priced at \$14,000.

Payment in full must accompany the entry form. If payment has not been received by closing date of December 8, 2017, the entry will be void.

Refunds: No cash refunds after closing date. Show credit will be given with a veterinarian's or a doctor's certificate/letter. RETURNED CHECKS for NSF will incur a \$40.00 fee and a void entry.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded in all classes of placements 1st through 6th place.

Arena: All Dressage Tests will be ridden in the indoor arena. Footing is silica sand and textile.

Dressage tests Intro, A, B and C and CT dressage tests Preliminary Test A and below will be ridden in a 20 m x 40 m arena. All other dressage tests, including Preliminary Test B and Intermediate A and B, will be ridden in a 20 m x 60 m arena. Jumping will be in the fenced-in outdoor arena. Footing is silica sand and textile

Attire: Appropriate informal schooling attire is required. ASTM-SEI approved helmets and appropriate footwear is required and must be worn at all times when mounted.

Parking: Ample parking for cars and horse trailers. Cars will be parked separately from trailers. Trailers will be parked in the field immediately to the right as you enter the property. Volunteers will be on hand to assist with parking. Please follow the guidance of the volunteers, **park only in designated areas**.

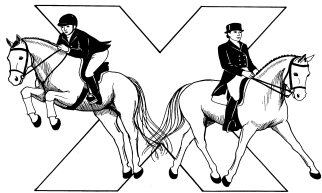
