Competitor Information:

Entries: All entries MUST include a copy of a current negative Coggins. The CDCTS/Stables at the Mains release form must be filled out, signed and dated by rider and/or parent or guardian if rider is younger than 18 years old. Stallions are permitted to show at Stables at the Mains.

USEF Rules State: Horses are limited to a maximum of three Dressage rides per day at Fourth Level and below or two Dressage rides per day above Fourth Level. Horses competing at both Fourth Level and Prix St. Georges, or their equivalents, are limited to two Dressage rides per day.

Payment in full must accompany the entry form. If payment has not been received by the closing date of Sunday, April 23, 2023, the entry will be void. **Payment by PayPal is also accepted. If you choose to use PayPal, make sure you scan or print a copy of your payment receipt and send it with your completed and signed show entry form so that the Show Secretary can confirm your payment. On-Grounds Schooling of Horse (non-competing horse)

Competitors who wish to take advantage of this opportunity need to provide a copy of negative coggins, pay the on-grounds fee, a bridle tag fee of \$2.00, and the office fee on or before the closing date. CDCTS and Stables at the Mains Hold Harmless Release must be signed as well. When the horse is on the grounds, the bridle tag must be worn at all times.

Awards:

Ribbons will be awarded in all classes of placements 1st through 6th place for Open, Adult Amateur and Junior rider. Overall Dressage high point will be awarded for Open, Adult Amateur and Junior rider. Overall Combined Training high point will be awarded for Open, Adult Amateur and Junior rider.

Arena:

All dressage tests will be ridden in the outdoor arena. Footing is sand and GGT. Warm up area will be in the covered arena and will be marked. The CT jump classes will be held in the designated grassy area.

Dressage tests for Classical Intro, A, B, C; All Working Equitation, Western Dressage Intro and Basic; All CT tests will be ridden in a 20 m x 40 m arena. All other dressage tests will be ridden in a 20 m x 60 m arena.

Jumping will be in an unfenced, grassy area.

Attire:

Appropriate informal schooling attire is required. Schooling show attire is considered a collared shirt with sleeves and appropriate footwear such as paddock boots or tall boots. ASTM-SEI approved helmets must be worn at all times when mounted.

Parking:

Cars may be parked separately from trailers, depending on numbers. Trailers will be parked in an assigned area. Volunteers will be on hand to assist with parking. Please follow the guidance of the volunteers, **park only in designated areas. **Please clean up manure around your horse trailer before leaving for the day****

Ride Times:

Official ride times will be posted on the CDCTS website and Facebook page on Thursday April 27, 2023 after 6 pm.

Concessions: Concessions will be available

Dogs: Dogs allowed and must remain on a leash. No exceptions.

Directions to Stables at the Mains:

GPS does not work. MapQuest has correct driving instructions, however, depending on which direction you are coming from, Big Springs Road is closed. See the below recommended directions.

From Lenoir City: NOTE: **Big Springs Road off Hwy 321 from Lenoir City is CLOSED** due to bridge construction. You need to follow Hwy 321 toward Maryville and turn right at William Blount Drive (Hwy 335) at the traffic light. Follow to the intersection with Big Springs Road and turn right (Dollar General). Continue on Big Springs Road, you will pass Jamback Farm on your left. Big Springs Road will veer to the right as it meets Walker Road coming from your left. Continue on Big Springs Road and turn left on Meadow Road. Follow Meadow Road and you will come to Stables at the Main entrance on your left.

From Maryville: Follow Hwy 321 toward Lenoir City. At the intersection with Weigel's, turn left onto S. Old Glory Road. Follow until it becomes Big Springs Road. Follow Big Springs Road, crossing over Willilam Blount Drive (Hwy 335) where you will see Dollar General. Continue on Big Springs Road, you will pass Jamback Farm on your left. Big Springs Road will veer to the right as it meets Walker Road coming from your left. Continue on Big Springs Road and turn left on Meadow Road. Follow Meadow Road and you will come to Stables at the Main entrance on your left.

From East Knoxville: I-40 west to exit 386B toward Alcoa Hwy/Airport/Smoky Mts onto US-129 (Alcoa Hwy). Go for 21.0 mi. Continue on US Highway 411 S (US-411) toward Fort Loudon. Go for 7.0 mi. Turn right onto TN-95 S (TN-95) toward Greenback/Lenoir City. Go for 2.0 mi. Turn right onto Morganton Rd. Go for 1.0 mi. Turn left onto Meadow Rd W. Go for 420 ft.
