"I learned to feel the imbalances in my seat bones (and even worked on that driving to work this morning). She also gave me several exercises that will hopefully help my horse with his neurological issues. Thank you so much for brining her in for a clinic. It was an amazing weekend." - **Gena Brown**

Two things that Emily helped me with were straightness (especially in my upper body/ shoulders) and helping me be more aware to not lock up my pelvis.' - **Deena Langley**



"I learned that my inability to correct my leg position is due to my pelvic tilt being wrong, which is hampered by a stuck hip flexor. Moving forward I will go to physical therapy to get my stuck left hip flexor released. My hip flexor spasms painfully when my leg is placed correctly, so I need outside intervention to assist with releasing it so I can improve my alignment as a rider and correct my leg and hip positioning." - **Aimee Glenn**



I learned so much from this clinic but the biggest thing was proper use of my seat. It was found I was sitting too far back in my saddle and needed to sit more up on my seat bones. This changed everything for me and my horse! - **Sloan Adams**





One comment I have gotten from multiple instructors and clinicians is that they can tell me what I need to do, but they can't teach me "feel". Emily was able to help me understand what my hands and arms should feel like in the contact. Utilizing the bands helped me understand that pushing my hands forward shouldn't use my biceps, but instead my triceps. The response in my horse was absolutely incredible - he was in the contact instead of being inverted or fighting me. I think the biggest takeaway for everyone should be how our equitation affects the horse! - **Kacy Schnake**

Arena:

All Dressage Tests will be ridden in a covered arena. Footing is sand and gravel. Warm up area will be marked. Lunging will be in a small paddock. Jumping will be in an unfenced, grassy area.

Dressage tests for Classical Intro, A, B, C; Western Dressage Intro and Basic; All Combined Training dressage tests will be ridden in a 20 m x 40 m arena—except for any Intermediate Combined Training tests. All other dressage tests will be ridden in a 20 m x 60 m arena. Must have at least 5 combined test entries to do the combined tests.

Jumping will be in an unfenced, grassy area.

Attire:

Appropriate informal schooling attire is required. ASTM-SEI approved helmets and appropriate footwear is required and must be worn at all times when mounted.

Parking: Cars may be parked separately from trailers, depending on numbers. Trailers will be parked in an assigned area. Volunteers will be on hand to assist with parking. Please follow the guidance of the volunteers, **park only in designated areas.**

USEF Rules State: Horses are limited to a maximum of three Dressage rides per day at Fourth Level and below or two Dressage rides per day above Fourth Level. Horses competing at both Fourth Level and Prix St. Georges, or their equivalents, are limited to two Dressage rides per day.

Awards:

Ribbons will be awarded in all classes of placements 1st through 6th place for Open, Adult Amateur and Junior rider.

Overall Dressage High Point will be awarded for Open, Adult Amateur and Junior rider

Arena: All Dressage Tests will be ridden in the main arena. Footing is sand. Warm up area will be in the lower arena.

Classical dressage tests Intro, A, B, C, all Working Equitation, Western Intro and Basic and all CT dressage tests will be ridden in a 20 m x 40 m arena. All other dressage tests will be ridden in a 20 m x 60 m arena.

Attire: Appropriate informal schooling attire is required. Schooling show attire is considered a collared shirt with sleeves and appropriate footwear such as paddock boots or tall boots. ASTM-SEI approved helmets are required and must be worn at all times when mounted. Face masks will be required if state mandates are in effect and are required for everyone, except when mounted.

Parking: Cars may be parked separately from trailers, depending on numbers. Trailers will be parked in an assigned area. Volunteers will be on hand to assist with parking. Please follow the guidance of the volunteers, **park only in designated areas.**

Ride Times: Official ride times will be posted on the CDCTS website and Facebook page on **Thursday June 13, 2024 after 6 p.m.**

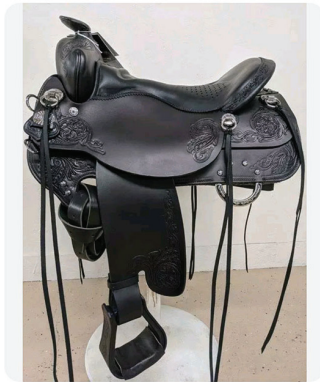

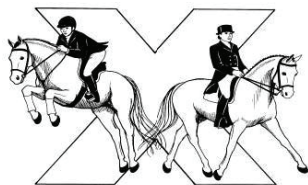

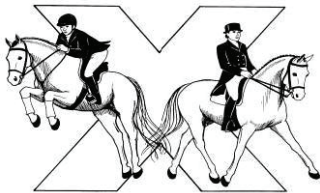
