Call to Order: Carolyn Ordal called the meeting to order at 7 p.m.

Approval of the Minutes: Susan Hill moved and Lynn Holtman seconded the motion that the previous meeting (January minutes) be approved. The motion was unanimously approved.

Treasurer's Report: Kacy Schnake gave the Treasurer's Report which included information from the Annual Banquet. Lynn Holtman moved to accept the report as presented and Susan Hill seconded the motion and it was approved unanimously.

Old Business:

Membership Committee Report: Carolyn Ordal gave Kacy Schnake 2 more membership renewals. Kacy is working on bringing the current membership list up-to-date.

2024 Shows/Events:

- The May Schooling Show is May 4 at The Stable at the Main. Marie McDonald is judging and Carolyn Ordal will be the show secretary for this event.
- The Summer Schooling Show is June 15 at Walnut Grove Stables, Debbie Schwartz is judging. A show secretary is needed for this event.
- The Fall Schooling Show is September 28. The place and judge is to be determined.
- Board members discussed a "Not Ready for Prime Time" fun show for this year for beginner riders, possibly in late July. Dalles Phillips, HA pony clubber; Horse management for USPC SE region; has evented, fox hunted and currently shows Saddlebreds in gaited classes and Western Dressage classes, has agreed to be the judge for this fun show. Susan Hill and Sloan Adams are working on class listings for the show.

Clinics/Seminars:

- Elizabeth Johnson, March 9-10 at Red Oak Hill Farm. Entries are due March 1
- Reaching Strides Equine Rehabilitation with Emily Rose Seminar April 13-14. Mandy Henderson obtained a \$2000 USDF grant for the club to help supplement this clinic to keep the fees to a more reasonable level. Emily will share her experience with becoming a balanced horse and rider pair as well as biomechanical principles related to riding.
