Spring is here (finally!) and we are all excited to get back to a regular riding schedule!

Spring is also the prime time to do a quick safety check on your saddle billets to make sure that those first spring rides are successful & safe.

First, place your saddle on a stand or a flat, cushioned surface (such as a blanket or saddle pad) to prevent scratches, in a well-lit area.

Let's check these 4 points:

- 1. Upper stitching attachment to the saddle Look for fraying thread or loose stitches.
- 2. Leather Integrity Check for dryness, cracking deeper than surface, & signs of rot.
- 3. Wear & Tear
  - a. Look at the top, bottom, and sides of each billet should be of even thickness.
  - b. Look at the holes. They should be even and not stretched or elongated.
- 4. What about billets with nylon in the middle? The same inspection  $\mathcal{E}$  points of concern apply! Even nylon is prone to stretching and damage!

If you encounter any of the above concerns, please contact your local saddle fitter (who is trained to replace them) or saddler to schedule an appointment. There may be other concerns that you encounter that need to be evaluated by a trained professional - reach out & we can help!

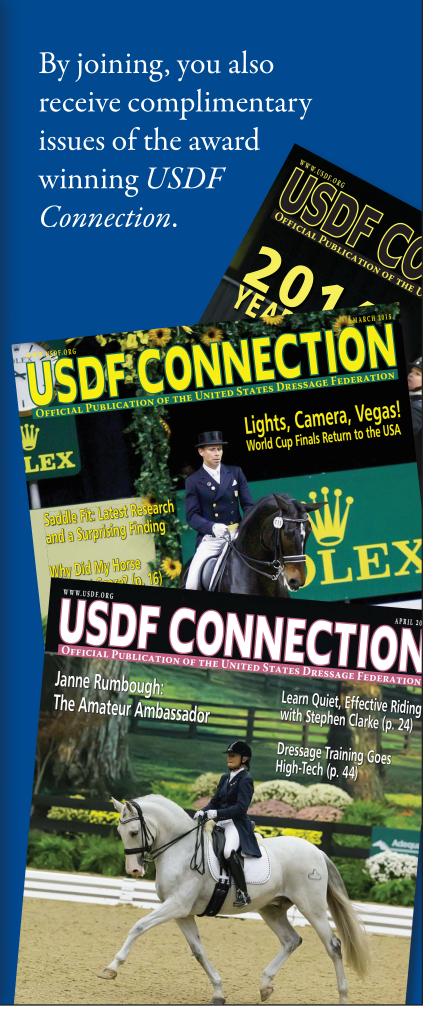
