Old Business

Membership Committee Report – Membership updates?

- To promote joining, we discussed the idea of adding flyer regarding year-end awards and a membership form to rider packets at shows.

June 15 Summer Schooling Show – entries? Are all volunteers in place? Who has condiments from Spring show? Carolyn will bring burgers, hot dogs, buns, cookies, ice, lettuce and tomato early on Saturday. We should have enough drinks and chips leftover.

- Julie Noe to bring grill parts day of show

July 8-9 Emily Rose clinic – What needs to be set up? Emily Rose asked to borrow a massage table — ask our professional member to borrow hers? Carolyn can attend in the afternoons by 2 p.m. (July 9 is our CDCTS meeting 6 p.m.)

- Still planned for Shannon O'Hatnick's, deposit due Saturday prior (July 6, 2024).
- Three riders are on wait list.
- Kacy Schnake can bring table, coffee, sandwiches Monday AM but must leave for work
- Susan can handle Tuesday but still need extra help for Monday.
- Still need massage table.
- There is a conflict with our July Board meeting Tues 7/9/24.
- Recommend moving meeting to Tues 7/2/2024

July 27 Not Ready for Prime time fun show – list of classes attached. Need a judge as Dalles Phillips is no longer able to do this. Are we going forward with this show? Will we make any money after we buy ribbons? Entry fees for similar shows are usually \$10-\$12/class for pre-registration and \$15 day of show. Would we be better off combining it with Fall Fun Day in October?

- Recommendation to postpone this show or combine with fall fun day. The four board members present did not feel we had sufficient resources at the meeting to make plans.
- Sloan Adams has a friend that might be an option for a judge should we decide to proceed with fun show. Cost may be prohibitive if he is unable to give a discount.
- Sloan suggested, and the group agreed, that we should use inexpensive ribbons for a fun show. No need to have them customized for CDCTS.

Trail ride in August? Panther Creek has been suggested as a site. What would appeal to get non-CDCTS folks to join us as a meet and greet? Or should we just do it as a club get-together?
