# CDCTS MEETING MINUTES, APRIL 13, 2021

## **I. Call to Order**

The meeting was called to order by CDCTS President Carolyn Ordal at 7:00 p.m. on April 13, 2021 at Fleet Foot Farm, Lenoir City, TN.

## **III. Approval of Minutes from Last Meeting**

Minutes from March 9, 2021 were provided to all members in the March newsletter. A motion to accept the minutes as presented was made by Alece Ellis and seconded by Susan Hill.

## **IV. Committee Reports**


