

VISITOR & VOLUNTER POLICIES & PROCEDURES



We're excited to share our sweet preschool with you! Below is important information to welcome volunteers and visitors safely into our learning environment.

GUEST!

Volunteers are directly supervised by the director/licensee or a facility employee with a criminal record clearance or exemption. Our volunteers spend no more than 16 hours per week at the facility. Volunteers are not left alone with children in care.

California law requires that school staff and volunteers working with children and community college students be free of infectious tuberculosis (TB) disease. Under SB 792, employees and volunteers of preschool facilities are required to have certain immunizations and tuberculosis screening. California preschool staff and volunteers must show proof of vaccination against these dangerous diseases: measles, whooping cough, and flu.

Respectfulness and Confidentiality: All grown-ups are responsible for maintaining complete confidentiality of all proprietary or privileged information to which they are exposed as volunteers and visitors. Please talk to the Lead Teacher or Director if you are volunteering and are concerned about a child or experience. Do not talk to the child's parents yourself. It is the school's responsibility to speak with parents about their child's experiences in the school.

Health and Safety: All grown-ups wash their hands upon arrival and throughout the day. Please do not visit when you are ill. Please see our Illness Policy and how we are healthy and safe as a preschool community.

Expectations and Agreements: Storybook is the first private preschool to be a Teaching Pyramid Partner Implementation site for the CA CSEFEL. In 2021, we joined the elite group of 21 preschool programs from across the state. Our educators will guide and support children's and adults' behaviors. Expectations are a framework for the behaviors that are expected of everyone in our program, including children, staff, and families, while at school. Expectations are best when set program-wide, and examples are created for specific settings.

Parents, guardians, visitors, and volunteers will dress appropriately while visiting our preschool. Dress to play and get messy!
