MEMBER CODE OF CONDUCT**

I recognize that it is a privilege to participate in the Warriors Robotics Corp. As with all privileges, there comes the responsibility to maintain that privilege.

As a Warriors Robotics Corp. Member, I will:

Do my best each day, remembering that all individuals have talents and weaknesses, including me.
Treat my coaches, teammates, other competitors and coaches, judges, officials, administrators, and fans with respect.

This respect includes communication through social media.

Have a positive attitude and encourage others.

Honor my commitment to my team by regularly attending practices and events.

Respect the hard work of others:

Only touch components, and work products, designed or created by others with their permission or the permission of the coaches.

Move carefully around the facility to minimize accidents

Offer positive support and constructive criticism

Use good sportsmanship and set an example for others.

Not engage in any form of bullying, harassment, use of profane or insulting language, or any actual or threatened violence.

Exhibit maturity and professionalism when dealing with difficult and stressful situations.

Follow these safety guidelines and any other safety instructions given to me:

Absolutely NO running or horseplay, in general.

No throwing materials or

No food or drinks near equipment (robots and computers) except closed water bottles. Food and other drinks may be consumed in a designated area, if one has been established.

Make sure your coach knows when you are leaving.

Respect the facilities and equipment provided at every event

Follow all rules as established by the team, local facility, program or league.

Everyone makes mistakes! It's part of being human. It is not intended that any statement in this document be used to unreasonably punish anyone for their mistake or their forgetfulness. On the other hand, a Member repeatedly making the same mistake, or purposefully acting against this Code of Conduct may be another matter – and may result in discipline, including temporary or permanent expulsion from the program depending on the specifics of the situation. Please be aware that if a Member is disciplined or removed from the program, no refund of the Participation Fee will be issued. Judgement and objectivity will always be parts of this process.

PARENT/GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT**

Warriors Robotics Corp. believe that Parents should play an integral role in the development of our Members. Through encouragement and good example, you: (a) help ensure that they learn good sportsmanship and self-discipline; (b) teach them to work together and sacrifice for the good of the group; (c) teach them to enjoy winning and deal, appropriately, with defeat; and, (d) encourage them to have fun.

To support these goals, Warriors Robotics Corp. has established the following guidelines:

Place the emotional and physical well-being of all players ahead of any personal desire to win.

Support the coaches, officials, and administrators working with my child, to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.

Make every effort to ensure that my child is attending team meetings, and, if there is a conflict on a date my child is expected to attend, I will notify the team or coach through the Team Snap.

Communicate with coaches, including, but not limited to, behaviors, food allergies, and a change in pick-up person.

Encourage good sportsmanship

Demonstrate positive support for all Participants, coaches, judges, officials, and administrators.

Treat players, coaches, judges, officials, administrators, and fans with respect. This includes communications through the use of social media.

Teach and expect Member to treat other players, coaches, judges, officials, administrators, and fans with respect.

Understand that judges and officials are doing their best.

Keep things positive with the opposing team's parents, players, and coaches.

Remember that the game and building of the robot is for the team members, not for adults.

Be positive and constructive.

Remain in the designated areas during the matches.

I will not interfere with the team's solutions, robot design, driver selection decisions or do my child's work for them.

Remember that I am always teaching my child through my behaviors. I will keep integrity in mind as I show my best face at competitions and events.

I understand that I will be notified if any issues or concerns arise with my child. If there are any problems with my child at meetings or at competitions, my child may be warned, and continued or serious issues may potentially lead to my child being dismissed from the team, with no refund of fees paid.

I know that I must accompany my child should we want to take part in team travel. If I am not able to travel with my child, I will find an appropriate guardian who will accept this responsibility.

I will endeavor to respect fellow parents' wishes if they do not want photos or videos of their child taken and or shared. However, I am aware that in certain public situations my child may be photographed at any time without the need of consent by any party.

LIABILITY RELEASE AND PERMISSION FORM**

Furthermore, on behalf of the Member, I hereby assume all risk of personal injury, sickness, death, damage, and expense as a result of participation in recreation and work activities involved therein. Further authorization and permission is hereby given to Warriors Robotics Corp. to furnish any necessary transportation, food, and lodging for the Member. In the event of travel, a parent or guardian will be required to attend and arrange transportation, unless directed by another parent or guardian. The organization is not required to supply transportation to and from any event, tournament or practices. The undersigned does also hereby give permission for the Member to ride in any vehicle designated by the adult in whose care the minor has been entrusted while attending and participating in activities sponsored by Warriors Robotics Corp.

The undersigned further agrees to hold harmless and indemnify Warriors Robotics Corp., the sponsors, directors, officers, coaches, employees, agents, assigns, legal representatives, mentors, parents, members, and successors, for any liability sustained by Warriors Robotics Corp. as the result of the negligent, willful, or intentional acts of the Member, including expenses incurred attendant thereto.

The undersigned acknowledges that this Waiver is given with the express intention of effecting the extinguishment of certain obligations owed to the Member by Warriors Robotics Corp., and with the intention of binding the Member's spouse, heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, and assigns.

The undersigned acknowledges and agrees with Warriors Robotics Corp. that: (1) Warriors Robotics Corp. has given the undersigned sufficient time to carefully read this Waiver, (2) the undersigned has been given the opportunity and has been encouraged to seek independent legal advice prior to signing this Waiver, (3) the undersigned fully understands the risks and claims that the Member is waiving to participate, (4) the undersigned is freely and voluntarily executing this Waiver, and (5) the undersigned and the Member are forever prevented from suing or otherwise claiming against Warriors Robotics Corp. for any property loss or personal injury that the Member may sustain while participating.
