## HEAD FOOTBALL COACH





Coach Jamie Aull has been the Head Football Coach for North Atlanta High School since 2020. In five seasons, Coach Aull has led the Warriors to unprecedented heights and built the program into a state football power.

Coach Aull was promoted to Head Football Coach after two seasons as an assistant. The Warriors produced a winning record in 2021. Then in 2022, the team not only advanced to the postseason for the second time in a quarter-century but won a playoff game for the first time in school history. The Warriors returned to the playoffs in 2023, and in 2024 they won the school's first region championship in football. The Atlanta Journal-Constitution named Coach Aull its 2024 Coach of the Year for Atlanta/South Fulton, and he has been honored as a region Coach of the Year three times.

Overall, Coach Aull's record at North Atlanta through 2024 stood at 35-17 (.673 winning percentage) with a region record of 18-10 (.643 winning percentage). The Warriors' record has improved year-over-year in each of his seasons. Ten of his players have received scholarships to play college football.

The North Atlanta Warrior football philosophy under Coach Aull requires players to be disciplined. They must outwork their opponents from January to July – from the end of one season until the beginning of the next. The Warriors will always play with a great deal of effort and enthusiasm.

Prior to joining North Atlanta, Coach Aull coached at his alma mater, Mount Zion High School in Jonesboro, from 2005-11, the last three seasons as Head Football Coach. He then served as Offensive Coordinator for Charles Drew High School in Riverdale from 2012-13 and in the same position for Griffin High School from 2014-15. Coach Aull served as Head Football Coach for Our Lady of Mercy Catholic High School in Fayetteville from 2016-17 before joining North Atlanta.

In his playing career as an offensive lineman, Coach Aull was named All-County three times and was honored as first-team All-State as a senior. He walked on at the University of West Georgia, eventually earning a football scholarship at guard and center. He graduated from West Georgia with a degree in History and later earned his master's degree from the University of Phoenix.

Besides his football duties, Coach Aull teaches weight training at North Atlanta. He and his wife, Angela, have three children: Jared (26), David (21) and Derrick (15).
