The DeLorenzo's Story

The pie you are waiting to receive is far more than just the highest quality pizza with warm friendly service. It's a pizza with a long, illustrious history.

The DeLorenzo's started their Tomato Pie trade back in 1938. Pasquale DeLorenzo, his wife Maria, and their eight sons and four daughters, opened their first pizzeria at the corner of Hudson and Mott Streets, in the Chambersburg section of Trenton. The older brothers perfected the dough and pizza making, while the younger brothers made the deliveries. Maria ran the business and the girls canned the tomatoes. A true family contribution made the DeLorenzo's Tomato Pie a Trenton icon.

The term "Tomato Pie" does not represent a drastically different concept in pizza, but does represent a Trenton tradition perfected and popularized by the DeLorenzo family.

Over the years, their business and family grew, and so did their locations. They opened several locations in the Greater Trenton area - the original location on the corner of Hudson and Mott, a second location on the corner of Broad and Ferry Streets, and a short lived location in rural Hopewell. When the older brothers were called to serve in World War II, the younger siblings took on the responsibility to run the restaurants. Rick DeLorenzo, along with his brother Pasquale, settled on Hamilton Avenue, while brother Chick settled near their original location on Hudson Street. Rick DeLorenzo, affectionately known as "Big Rick", created an environment where all customers were treated like family, and this feeling established a loyal customer base, contributing to the success of the business over the last 70 years. Today, second and third generation DeLorenzos have opened locations in Hamilton and Robbinsville, New Jersey.

Now at DeLorenzo's The Burg, you can experience third generation pie maker, and entrepreneur, Tyler DeLorenzo's pizza and culinary delicacies. A graduate of the New York City Institute of Culinary Education, Tyler brings the iconic Trenton Tomato Pie to Levittown, Pennsylvania, along with the tasty soups and sandwiches made famous by his grandfather "Big Rick" DeLorenzo. In addition to these old school favorites come a few new gourmet pies with a twist - the Margherita Pie, the Pork Roll Pie and the Mustard Pie.

Here at DeLorenzo's The Burg, our main goal is to create the same environment "Big Rick" and his brothers did back in 1938. A place to not only eat delicious tomato pies, but somewhere you can bond with your family and friends.

In addition to our location in Levittown we also have a state of the art custom built pizza trailer available for weddings, private events, and festivals. Have The Burg cater your next event or party either on-site or at this location.
