Angkor Highlights Tour Sunrise



• 04:45 AM – 05:00 AM: Getting picked up from hotel lobby and drive to Angkor Wat Temple

• 05:00 AM – 08:00 AM: Enjoy sunrise and explore Angkor Wat, the largest religious monument in the world and a symbol of Cambodia. Built in the early 12th century by King Suryavarman II, it was initially

dedicated to the Hindu god Vishnu before becoming a Buddhist temple. Its central towers symbolize Mount Meru, the center of the universe in Hindu and Buddhist cosmology.

• 08:30 AM – 08:30 AM: Enjoy coffee and your hotel-packed breakfast box in front of Angkor Wat Temple, with scenic views of the reflective ponds and majestic stone architecture.

• **08:30 AM** – **08:45 AM**: Visit **Angkor Thom**, the last great capital of the Khmer Empire, established by King Jayavarman VII. It features impressive defensive walls, gates with stone faces, and is surrounded by a moat.

• 08:45 AM – 08:50 AM: Drive to Bayon Temple

• **08:50 AM** – **09:30 AM**: Visit **Bayon Temple**, famous for its 54 towers decorated with 216 smiling stone faces believed to represent either King Jayavarman VII or the bodhisattva

Avalokiteshvara. The temple also has intricate bas-reliefs depicting daily life and historical events. If lucky, you may also spot monkeys near the west gate.

• 09:30 AM – 09:40 AM: Drive to Tanei Temple



• 09:40 AM – 10:00 AM: Visit Tanei Temple, a small, secluded temple deep in the jungle, offering an untouched and quiet experience of Angkor architecture. It remains unrestored, with trees and roots embracing its ancient stones.

• 10:00 AM – 10:10 AM: Drive to Ta Prohm Temple

• 10:10 AM – 11:10 AM: Visit Ta Prohm Temple, internationally



famous for the massive tree roots growing over its ruins, creating a photogenic blend of

architecture and nature. Known as the "Tomb Raider Temple," it was used as a filming location for the Angelina Jolie movie.

• 11:10 AM – 11:20 AM: Drive



• 11:20 AM – 12:20 PM: Stroll around Preah Dak Village, a







traditional Khmer village where you'll observe authentic Cambodian rural life. Sample local treats like sugar palm cake and sticky rice balls, and enjoy a rustic lunch with unique items like grilled frog and Khmer snacks. This village is known for its hospitality and cultural richness.

• 12:20 PM – 01:00 PM: Return back to the hotel for the rest of the day
