- 1. Fish Eligibility:
- > a. Must be member's own fish.
- **b.** Must have been in possession 21 days prior to competition.
- 2. Competition is open to members in good standing only.
- 3. Judges:
- ➤ a. Judges (1-3) selected from membership (experienced hobbyists).
- > b. Judges not allowed to participate except by "Exhibit Only" and shall receive one point for exhibiting.
- 4. Awards:
- ➤ a. Monthly: Ribbons for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places.
- ➤ b. Annually: 1st place Trophy
- > c. Points earned monthly on this scale:
 - 5 points 1st place
 - 3 points 2nd place
 - 2 points 3rd place
 - 1 point for showing if not placing (1 point max. per class)
- d. Competition runs January through December.
- 5. Bowl:
- > a. Flat sided
- b. Glass
- c. Non tinted
- ➤ d. Tanks larger than 5 gallons participants shall furnish stand (large fish only)
- > e. Black background paint, paper or plastic attached to bowl
- ➤ f. Bowl shall be covered
- g. No air, heater, or light. Judge will have a flashlight
- h. No gravel, plants or decorations (except bowl beautiful)
- 6. Water
- > a. Participant must furnish water
- > b. No tint except amber color required for acid loving fish
- 7. IBC and IFGA points to be used for Bettas and Guppies
- 8. References:
- > a. As available in the EIAA library
- 9. Miscellaneous:
- > a. Decisions of the judges are final
- > b. Ties decided by the top presiding, non-participating, officer at the meeting
- > c. Any sick, deformed or malnutrition fish shall be disqualified ant the discretion of the judge
- > d. In the bowl beautiful class, bowl must contain fish
- > e. "Natives" refers to fish native to North America excluding marine
