Misc:

Stazon Stamp Pad (Black)

To Begin:

This is very easy to do!

Base the wooden tags with Titanium White. Let it dry well.

Load the Pumpkin Stamp on the Stamp Pad and press to the wooden tags. Set them aside to dry.

Apply a wash of Cobalt Teal Hue to the background of the tag, keep the darkest value to the edges of the Pumpkin.

Apply a wash of the Vermillion to the Pumpkin, shade the details of the pumpkin with floats of thinned Quinacridone Gold. Highlight with a stroke of Titanium/Vermillion.

Base the Stem and vine on the pumpkin with the green Gold.

Float the edges of the pin with thinned Asphaltum.
