and Dynasty Faux Squirrel Brushes



- 1** Base the entire cherry with Cherry Merlot. Let it dry.



- 2** Glaze the lower right side with a thin wash of Tuscan Red to create a mid-tone and roundness.



- 3** Deepen the shadow on the lower right with a float of thinned Soft Black.



- 4** Deepen the deepest shadow at the very bottom with a float of thinned Asphaltum.



- 5** Add a crescent of Warm White on the upper left side for the main highlight.



- 6** Add a smaller dot of Warm White just above the crescent for extra sparkle.



- 7** Blend and soften the highlight slightly by glazing around it with a very thin wash of Cherry Merlot.



- 8** Add a few tiny reflected highlights along the lower front edge with a very thin line of Warm White.



- 9** Your Cherry is Complete!

Warm White Lamp Black Lavender Haze Asphaltum After Dark

and Dynasty Faux Squirrel Brushes

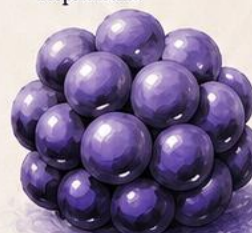
- 1** Base each individual drupe (the little berry bumps) with Lavender Haze. Let it dry.



- 2** Add a float of After Dark on the bottom left side of each drupe to create depth and form.



- 3** Deepen the shadows between the drupe and on the lower left with a float of thinned Asphaltum.



- 4** Add a few tiny touches of Lamp Black in the deepest recesses for extra contrast.



- 5** Add a small dot of Warm White on the upper right of each drupe for a soft highlight.



- 6** Add a slightly larger dot or short stroke of Warm White on the main light side of each drupe.



- 7** Soften some highlights by glazing over the lower left with a very thin wash of After Dark.



- 8** Add a tiny reflected highlight along the bottom edge of a few drupe with a very thin line of Warm White.



- 9** Your Blackberries are Complete! ♥

1

Base the entire lemon with Baby Duck. Let it dry.



2

Glaze the lower right side of the lemon with Saffron Yellow to create a mid-tone and roundness.



3

Shade the lower right side with a float of thinned Orange Flame to add warmth.



4

Deepen the shadow at the very bottom and along the lower right edge with a float of thinned Asphaltum.



5

Add a soft transition between the mid-tone and shadow with a very light glaze of Saffron Yellow to smooth and blend.



6

Add a crescent highlight on the upper left side with Warm White.



7

Blend and soften the highlight by glazing around it with a very thin wash of Baby Duck.



8

Add tiny texture marks and pores with a very light stipple of Saffron Yellow. Add a few tiny reflected highlights at the bottom with Warm White.

Let's Paint Strawberries!

Using DecoArt Americana Acrylic Colours



Warm White

Country Red

Tuscan Red

Cherry Merlot

Marigold

Asphaltum

and Dynasty Faux Squirrel Brushes



1

Base the entire strawberry with Country Red. Let it dry.



2

Glaze the top half with Tuscan Red to create a mid-tone and roundness. Let it dry.



3

Glaze the top and sides with Cherry Merlot, leaving a lighter area on the lower front. Let it dry.



4

Add warmth and glow to the lower front with a float of thinned Marigold.



5

Deepen the shadows around the top (under the leaves) and along the sides with a float of thinned Asphaltum.



6

Add a few tiny seeds using Marigold. Vary the size and spacing.



7

Add tiny highlights to each seed with a touch of Warm White on the upper left side of each seed.



8

Add a soft highlight on the upper left curve of the strawberry with a very thin glaze of Warm White.

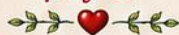

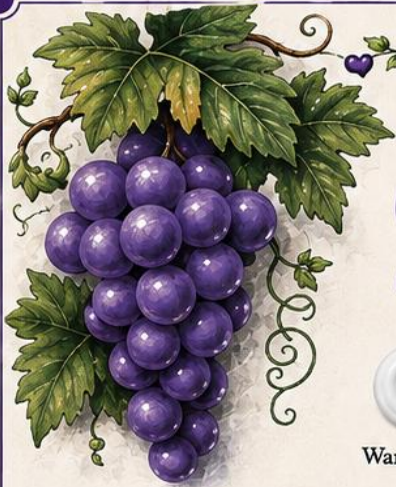

Warm White Purple Iris Soft Black Cherry Merlot

and Dynasty Faux Squirrel Brushes



- 1** Base each grape with Purple Iris. Let them dry.



- 2** Float thinned Warm White lightly on the upper left side of each grape.



- 3** Add a float of thinned Soft Black on the lower right side of each grape to create the shadow.



- 4** Deepen the shadow on the lower right side with a float of heavily thinned Soft Black.



- 5** Glaze the lower right edges with a very thin Cherry Merlot to enrich the colour.



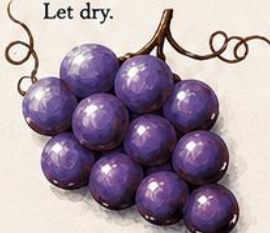
- 6** Add a tiny dot of Warm White on the upper left for a bright highlight.



- 7** Add a few tiny reflected highlights along the lower right edge with very thin Warm White.



- 8** Connect your grapes with a stem using Cherry Merlot and add a few tendrils. Let dry.



- 9** *Your Grapes are Complete!*

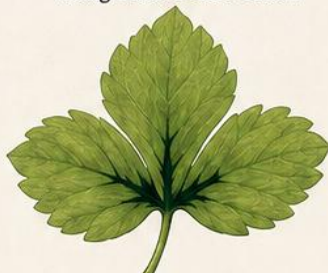
1

Base the entire leaf with
Lush Green.
Let it dry.



2

Paint a "U" shaped design
at the base of each leaflet
(where they meet the stem)
using Black Forest Green.



3

Pull the Black Forest Green
up the center vein of each
leaflet, then flick out toward
the edges with the tip of
your brush.



4

Add feathered strokes of
Black Forest Green along
the outer edges and
between the veins.



5

Add highlights to the tips
and outer edges of the leaflets
with Margarita using the
side of your brush.



6

Add a few soft highlight
strokes along the center
veins with Margarita.



7

Deepen the shadows at the
base and between the leaflets
with a thin wash of
Asphaltum.



8

Soften and blend the shadows
while keeping the highlights
bright and crisp.



9

and Dynasty Faux Squirrel Brushes



- 1 Base the entire lemon slice (with rind and segments) with Baby Duck. Let it dry.



- 2 Glaze the rind (outer edge) with Saffron Yellow to create a brighter yellow. Let it dry.



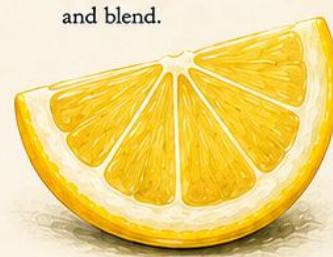
- 3 Add a float of thinned Orange Flame on the lower right side of the rind and each segment for warmth.



- 4 Deepen the shadow on the lower right side of the rind and segments with a float of thinned Asphaltum.



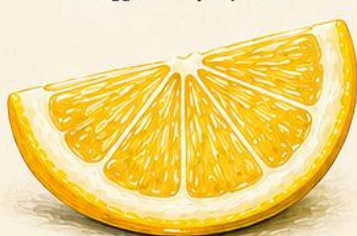
- 5 Add a soft transition between the mid-tones and shadows with a very light glaze of Saffron Yellow to smooth and blend.



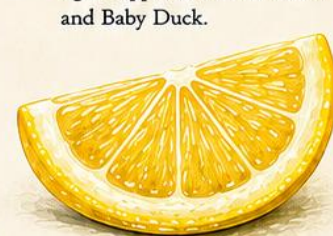
- 6 Add highlights to the edges of the segments and along the inner rind with Warm White.



- 7 Add small dots and streaks of Warm White within each segment to suggest the juicy texture.



- 8 Add a few tiny pores and texture marks on the rind with a very light stipple of Saffron Yellow and Baby Duck.



- 9 *Your Lemon Slice is Complete!*

Warm White



Bahama Blue



Prussian Blue



- 1 Base the entire droplet with Warm White. Let it dry.



- 2 Float thinned Bahama Blue around the lower edge of the droplet to create a soft shadow and hint of colour.



- 3 Deepen the shadow along the bottom edge with a float of thinned Prussian Blue. Keep the top light.



- 4 Add a small crescent of Warm White on the upper left side for the highlight.



- 5 Add a tiny dot of Warm White just above the crescent highlight for extra sparkle.



- 6 Glaze the edges lightly with very thin Prussian Blue to enhance the contrast and roundness.



- 7 Soften the transition by floating a little more thinned Bahama Blue around the lower edges.



- 8 Add a few tiny reflected highlights on the lower edge with very thin Warm White.



- 9 *Your Water Droplet is Complete!*
