- 1** Base the entire candy corn with Warm White. Let it dry.



- 2** Paint the middle section with Orange Flame. Start just below the tip and blend down slightly to soften the top edge.



- 3** Paint the bottom section with Sunny Day. Blend up slightly into the Orange Flame to soften the transition.



- 4** Add shading to the right side of the candy corn with a mix of Asphaltum and a little water. Blend well.



- 5** Deepen the shadow along the bottom edge with more Asphaltum. Keep the highlight on the left side.



- 6** Add a soft blended line between the white tip and orange section using a very light touch of Asphaltum. Blend gently.



- 7** Add a soft blended line between the orange and yellow sections using a very light touch of Asphaltum. Blend gently.



- 8** Add tiny highlights on the left side with Warm White to the tip and the left edge for a rounded, glossy look.



- 9** Your Candy Corn is Complete!

Let's Paint a Cute Halloween Bat!

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Warm White Orange Flame Sunny Day Asphaltum Lamp Black Lavender Haze

and Dynasty Faux Squirrel Brushes

- 1** Base the entire bat with Lamp Black. Let it dry.



- 2** Add a soft highlight to the fur and wings with a mix of Asphaltum and a little Lavender Haze. Blend well.



- 3** Add more highlights to the tips of the fur, ears and wings with Lavender Haze. Blend gently for a soft, furry look.



- 4** Add a soft highlight to the forehead, cheeks and belly with Warm White. Blend well.



- 5** Paint the inner ears and wing membranes with Lavender Haze. Blend in some Asphaltum near the edges for depth.



- 6** Add a soft glow around the bat against the background using Sunny Day, blending outward to create a moonlight effect.



- 7** Add a richer orange glow around parts of the moon with Orange Flame. Blend well into the yellow.



- 8** Deepen the shadows on the bat with a mix of Asphaltum and Lamp Black in the deepest areas: under the chin, around the body and wing joints.



- 9** Add highlights with Warm White to the eyes, nose and fangs. Add a touch of Lavender Haze to the nose and inside mouth. Finish with tiny dots of white around the bat for a magical twinkle!

Jack O' Lantern!

Using DecoArt Americana Acrylic Colours

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The perfect brush
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Warm White Orange Flame Sunny Day Asphaltum Lamp Black Plantation Pine

and Dynasty Faux Squirrel Brushes

- 1** Base the entire pumpkin with Orange Flame. Let it dry.



- 2** Add Sunny Day to the centre front area. Blend into the Orange Flame leaving the edges and crevices darker.



- 3** Deepen the shadows in the crevices, around the stem and the bottom with a mix of Asphaltum and Orange Flame.



- 4** Add a soft highlight on the ridges with Warm White. Keep the highlights on the left side where the light hits.



- 5** Paint the face shapes with Lamp Black.



- 6** Add Sunny Day to the edges of the face shapes on the inside to create a glow.



- 7** Deepen the inside of the face shapes with a mix of Asphaltum and Lamp Black.



- 8** Add a soft highlight with Warm White to the inner bottom edges of the mouth and eyes for a glowing effect. Add tiny highlights on the ridges.



- 9** Your Jack O' Lantern is Complete!

- 1** Base the entire mummy with Warm White. Let it dry.



- 2** Add shadows between the bandages and in the folds with a mix of Asphaltum and a little Lamp Black. Blend well.



- 3** Deepen the darkest areas (under the arms, between legs, under the bandages and around the eyes) with Lamp Black. Blend well.



- 4** Use a soft brush to add highlights on the raised edges of the bandages with Warm White. Blend well.



- 5** Add a very light glaze of Avocado Toast in some of the shadowed areas and on selected bandage strips for an aged, mummy look.



- 6** Deepen some areas with a mix of Asphaltum and Lamp Black to increase contrast and separation between layers.



- 7** Add tiny cracks, frayed edges and little dots of wear with a fine tip brush using a mix of Asphaltum and Lamp Black. Blend softly.



- 8** Add subtle tints of Avocado Toast to a few more strips and blend lightly for variation and interest.



- 9** Add final highlights with Warm White to the top edges of some bandages and a tiny dot in each eye for a lively sparkle!

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STEP BY STEP

Let's Paint a CUTE VOO DOO DOLL!

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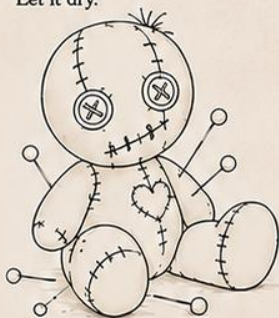
Using DecoArt Americana Acrylic Colours



Warm White Asphaltum Lamp Black Avocado Toast Country Red



- 1** Base the entire doll with Warm White. Let it dry.



- 2** Add shadows and aging with a mix of Asphaltum and Lamp Black. Shade around seams, under the head, arms, legs and body. Blend well.



- 3** Deepen the darkest areas with more of the Asphaltum and Lamp Black mix. Add extra shading to the seams, buttons and pins.



- 4** Add soft highlights to the raised areas with Warm White. Blend well.



- 5** Glaze lightly with Avocado Toast in random areas for a subtle aged, dirty look. Blend well.



- 6** Paint the heart patch and pin heads with Country Red. Add stitches on the heart with Lamp Black. Let dry.



- 7** Add more depth around the heart and seams with the Asphaltum and Lamp Black mix. Blend well.



- 8** Add tiny stitches and cross stitches on the doll using Lamp Black. Add little wear marks and dots for texture.



- 9** Add final highlights with Warm White to the top of the head, arms, legs and heart for a finished look!

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STEP BY STEP

Let's Paint a Cute Halloween Cat!

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Using DecoArt Americana Acrylic Colours



and Dynasty Faux Squirrel Brushes

- 1** Base the entire cat with Lamp Black. Let it dry.



- 2** Add a mix of Asphaltum and Lamp Black to the body for a soft fur texture. Blend well.



- 3** Add Lavender Haze to the face, chest and inside ears. Blend with a little Asphaltum in the shadows for depth.



- 4** Add a soft highlight to the fur on the cheeks, chest, paws and tail with Warm White. Blend well.



- 5** Paint the eyes with Sunny Day. Add Lamp Black pupils. Add a small dot of Warm White for the sparkle.



- 6** Add a soft pink nose with a mix of Warm White and a touch of Lavender Haze. Add small whisker dots with Warm White.



- 7** Paint the collar and pumpkin charm with Orange Flame. Add Sunny Day to the pumpkin face for a glow.



- 8** Deepen shadows on the fur with a mix of Asphaltum and Lamp Black in the darkest areas.



- 9** Add final highlights with Warm White to the fur, whiskers and eyes. Add a soft glow around the cat with Sunny Day and Lavender Haze.
