## DAISY PIN

Lamp Black, Warm White, Bahama Blue, Asphaltum, Baby Duck, Saffron Yellow, Orange Flame, DecoArt Matt Spray

Dynasty Black Gold Brushes

3/8 Angled Shader, 10/0 Liner, #4 Round

Misc:

Black Gel Pen, Pin Back, Glue

### The Daisies:

On The Palette: Warm White, Tea Berry, Baby Duck, Bahama Blue, Asphaltum.

Stroke in the petals toward the back with Warm White and a #5 Round Brush. Base the center with Warm White. Let it dry then base the center with Baby Duck. Stroke in the forward petals with Warm White. Shade the petals where they overlap and at the point nearest the centre of the flower with a float of thinned Bahama Blue. Let it dry and then float over it with heavily thinned Asphaltum. Shade the centre at the bottom and in the dip in the centre with A float of Tea Berry. Let it dry. Float over the shadows with thinned Asphaltum. Add dip dots of Asphaltum to the bottom and centre of the Daisies, then a final highlight with Dip Dots of Warm White. Add a scribbly outline to each of the petals and the centers with the Black Gel Pen.

**Finishing:** Lightly Spray the Daisy with one or two coats of DecoArt Matt Spray. You can then varnish with you favourite Varnish. Glue the pin back to the center of the back of the daisy.
