and Dynasty Faux Squirrel Brushes

- 1** Base the entire plum with Warm White. Let it dry.



- 2** Mix Lavender Haze with a touch of After Dark and glaze over the plum, leaving a lighter area on the upper left for the highlight.



- 3** Deepen the shadow on the right side and bottom with a mix of After Dark and a touch of Asphaltum.



- 4** Add Crimson Red to the mid-tones on the left and center of the plum. Blend softly into the purple.



- 5** Glaze the deepest shadow areas on the lower right and bottom with a mix of After Dark and Asphaltum.



- 6** Add a soft reflection on the right side with a thin glaze of Lavender Haze mixed with a little Warm White.



- 7** Add the main highlight on the upper left with Warm White. Blend the edges slightly.



- 8** Add tiny speckles and subtle texture with a fine mix of Warm White, Lavender Haze, and a touch of Crimson Red.



- 9** Your Ripe Plum is Complete!

- 1** Base the entire apple with Warm White. Let it dry.



- 2** Float Crimson Red over the top half of the apple, leaving the bottom lighter. Blend softly into the Warm White.



- 3** Add Country Red to the mid-tones and lower areas. Blend into the Crimson Red on top and leave the highlight area lighter on the upper left side.



- 4** Deepen the shadow on the right side and around the stem with a mix of Asphaltum and a bit of Country Red.



- 5** Add tiny vertical strokes and soft blending with Country Red and Crimson Red to create texture and a natural look.



- 6** Add the main highlight on the upper left with Warm White. Softly blend the edges.



- 7** Glaze the deepest shadows again with a thin mix of Asphaltum to enhance depth and contrast.



- 8** Paint the stem with Asphaltum and touch the left side with Plantation Pine for a natural tone. Add a leaf with Plantation Pine.



- 9** Your Apple is Complete!

and Dynasty Faux Squirrel Brushes

- 1** Base the entire mandarin with Tangerine. Let it dry.



- 2** Add Orange Flame to the lower right side and around the base. Blend up into the Tangerine on the upper left.



- 3** Deepen the shadow on the lower right side and under the stem with a mix of Asphaltum and Orange Flame.



- 4** Add subtle texture by dabbing tiny speckles and pores with a mix of Tangerine and Asphaltum.



- 5** Add highlights to the upper left curve with a very light glaze of Tangerine and a touch of Warm White.



- 6** Add tiny bright highlights (dimples) with Warm White on the upper left area.



- 7** Glaze the deepest shadow areas again with a thin mix of Asphaltum to increase depth and contrast.



- 8** Paint the stem with Plantation Pine. Add a touch of Asphaltum on the right side of the stem for shadow and depth.



- 9** Your Mandarin Orange is Complete! ♥

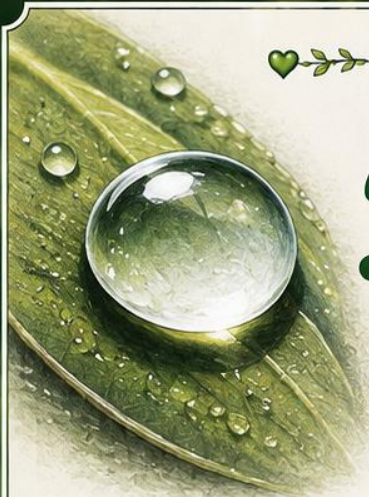

Warm White Foliage Green Plantation Pine Asphaltum

and Dynasty Faux Squirrel Brushes



- 1** Base the entire dewdrop using Warm White. Let it dry.



- 2** Glaze the lower edge and shadow area with a mix of Foliage Green and Plantation Pine. Soften the top edge.



- 3** Deepen the shadow at the bottom with a touch of Plantation Pine and Asphaltum.



- 4** Add a soft band of Foliage Green inside the lower curve of the dewdrop. Blend smoothly.



- 5** Add a very thin glaze of Plantation Pine to the deepest shadow area to increase depth and contrast.



- 6** Add the bright highlight on the upper left side with Warm White.



- 7** Add reflected highlights along the lower edge with a thin line of Warm White.



- 8** Add tiny bright sparkles and reflections inside the dewdrop with a fine touch of Warm White.
