Commencing Part way through the Year?

Students enrolling in Year 1 – 9 may enrol part way through the year and still pay only 1/12 the annual fee per month. For Year 10-12 Award Students, the total fee remains the same for a whole year, part year, or Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL).
