Code of Conduct & Christian Discipline

- 1. The member must be a born again believer and should have a consistent walk with the Lord Jesus Christ.**
- 2. The member should have gone through the waters of baptism in immersion according to the church's statement of faith.**
- 3. The member must have an exemplary lifestyle before God and fellow believers and the community he/ she lives in.**
- 4. The member must be mature in the faith and must be able to take responsibility in the Church and uphold the testimony of their life.**
- 5. The member should always hold the Church and its responsibilities / activities as an important priority in life.**
- 6. The member must encourage, admonish and edify other fellow Christians in their time of need as a ministry to the Church. The member also at the same time must be open to correction, rebuke and chastisement himself / herself, thus submitting to discipline, if necessary.**
- 7. The member must completely abstain from all forms of impurities i.e. Alcohol, Smoking, Drugs, and Tobacco etc. And other such addictives and maintain purity therein.**
- 8. The member must be aware he / she must maintain a life of utmost purity and holiness by staying away from adultery and fornication thus adding to the credibility of their testimony.**
- 9. The member must feel their responsibility of tithing to the Church as required by the word of God and also as a**

ministry to the Church. The member must also feel responsible as a contributing member financially in the church in terms of offerings and special donations.

- 10. The member is expected by the leadership of the church to keep the unity of the local church and should not gossip, slander, false testimony, immorality, uncleanness etc., as stated in Galatians 5: 19 - 20.**
- 11. The member must voluntarily avail himself / herself for any ministry of the church feeling the need at the required time.**
- 12. The member has a right of expressing their feelings to the pastoral leadership for the betterment of the church.**
- 13. The member must take the responsibility of the ministry of bringing others to the Lord in salvation adding them to the Church.**
