Cliff Notes:

WAITING PERIOD, 2 year waiting period since the closing date of purchase (this applies to new homeowners).

RENTAL CAP, Rentals in the HOA should not exceed 20% of total properties. As of August 2023, we are at our max capacity and any new rental opportunity would need to be on a waitlist
