CHECK-OUT INSTRUCTIONS

Please check out promptly by 10:00 am so that we can prepare the house for our next guests. If your plans change and you would like a late check-out, we may be able to accommodate this depending on availability. Let us know and we'll do our best to arrange it for you.

- Lock all glass sliders and doors when leaving the property. Return all keys to the lockbox located to the left of the front door.
- Please put the AC back to 76 degrees.
- Please pull curtains shut on living room glass sliders. This helps keep the property cool after your departure.
- Refrigerator and Freezer: Please remove any cold items from refrigerator and freezers. Anything else that you didn't open can stay if you so desire for the next quest.
- Sometimes we need to rearrange things to accommodate our friends and family, please put back any and all furniture you may have moved.
- Load and start the dishwasher.
- Take out all trash and place in outdoor waste bins. Trash day is on Thursday at 6am.
- We all live on Apps nowadays, don't let everyone else live off yours for free. Log out of your TV Accounts before you leave. Property Managers and Owners are not responsible for any charges to tenants' accounts.
- Pick up all dog poop, failure to remove all will result in a \$50 charge.
- Clean Grill: Failure to clean out grill will result in a \$50 charge.





No Smoking or Vaping

Smoking is strictly prohibited within the residence. If you wish to smoke, do so outdoors beyond the pool areas (in grass) or if applicable by the boat dock. Please dispose of cigarette butts in a trash receptacle. No illegal substances or activities allowed.

We understand that you may be here to party on your vacation and rightfully so! We encourage you to have a fantastic time. However, we strive on guest safety and strictly prohibit the consumption of alcohol to any persons under the age of 21. Please drink responsibly.

Quiet Hours

Please observe quiet hours from 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM to maintain a peaceful environment for everyone. Be mindful of noise levels, especially when entering or leaving the building during these hours.





CLEANING & TIDYNESS

We take pride in maintaining a clean and welcoming environment. Kindly clean up after yourself and before checkout, and ensure all dishes are washed and trash is properly disposed of in the designated bins.

When you're leaving, please place all towels in the laundry room. Kindly start a laundry load of BEACH TOWELS. Please leave all the linens on the beds. This makes it easier for inspection and spot removal. Lastly, remember to pickup any and all pet waste and clean the grill to avoid a \$50 FEE.



OTHER RULES

- Clean and turn off all propane tanks after each grill use.
- NO GLASS, SEA SHELLS, or ROCKS of any kind near or in the pool.
- All pool toys and equipment can be put back in the designated POOL BIN, or if applicable, POOL STORAGE CLOSET on lanai.
- Lock all glass sliders and doors when leaving the property.
- Return the thermostat to 76 degrees upon departure from the property.
- NO PARTIES allowed UNLESS arranged with the Property Manager.

Pool Service Each Week

As part of our goal to provide the best vacation experience possible there is a responsibilty to maintain each property according to our high standards. This maintenance includes the pool, which is done weekly by a professional pool company.

- Do not block screen doors, gates, or other entrances to the pool area to ensure the professionals have access for prompt and efficient pool service.
- Guests are not allowed to refuse pool services, doing so will result in a \$100 return trip charge and other potential pool fees should the water need additional treatment (to be paid by the guests).
 - If a pool is not properly serviced each week, due to the high heat temperatures of Florida, the result can be rapid algae growth that can turn the pool green within 48 to 72 hours.

Napoleon Prestige PRO 500 Grill Instructions – Coconut Shack

Enjoy grilling at the Coconut Shack with our premium Napoleon PRO 500 gas grill! Please follow these instructions to ensure safe and efficient use.

1. Safety First

- Use the grill outdoors only in a well-ventilated area.
- Never leave the grill unattended while in use.
- Keep children and pets away from the grill.
- Always turn off the burners and gas supply after grilling.
- Allow grill to cool completely before covering or cleaning.

2. Lighting the Main Burners

- 1. Open the grill lid completely.
- 2. Turn on the gas supply (propane tank or natural gas line).
- 3. Press and turn a main burner knob to the 'Ignite' position.
- 4. Press the igniter button until the burner lights (you may hear a click).
- 5. Repeat for additional burners as needed.
- 6. Preheat the grill for 10-15 minutes with the lid closed before cooking.

3. Using the Infrared Side Burner (Sizzle Zone)

- 1. Open the lid of the side burner.
- 2. Turn the burner knob to 'Ignite' and press the igniter.
- 3. Wait 3-5 minutes for the burner surface to glow red.
- 4. Ideal for searing steaks or other high-heat grilling.



4. Using the Rear Infrared Rotisserie Burner

- 1. Place food securely on the rotisserie spit rod.
- 2. Insert the rod into the motor and bracket slots.
- 3. Turn the rear burner knob to 'Ignite' and press the igniter.
- 4. Switch on the rotisserie motor.
- 5. Use a drip tray underneath and monitor food regularly.

5. After Grilling

- Turn off all burner knobs and the gas supply.
- Leave the lid closed and set burners to high for 5-10 minutes to burn off residue.
- After cooling, use a grill brush to clean grates.
- Empty the grease tray once completely cool.
- Cover the grill only when it is fully cooled down.

6. Helpful Tips

- Use built-in grill lights and LED knobs for nighttime grilling.
- Keep grilling utensils and tools stored nearby for convenience.
- If unsure about operation, please don't use the grill.

Coconut Shack – Outdoor Essentials & Reminders

Thank you for staying with us at the Coconut Shack in Fort Myers Beach! Here are a few helpful tips to make your stay even more enjoyable.

Beach Towels & Clean-Up

- Beach towels are located in the basket on the ground floor.
- Please hang wet towels on the hooks by the pool or the post to dry.
- After enjoying the beach or pool, hose down all beach gear, pool equipment, kayaks, and bikes to keep them clean and sand-free.

Screened-In Porch Tips

- To get the most out of your time on the porch, enjoy the fresh air and views!
- If a storm is coming, please move cushions to the chairs near the windows to keep them dry.
- Chair covers for the brown coral gliders are stored under the seat cushions—feel free to use them.

Outdoor Kitchen & Dish Use

- The outdoor kitchen includes grilling utensils, dishes, grill baskets, a pot, a cast iron pan, and a refrigerator for your convenience.
- Please note there is no garbage disposal, so be sure to use the strainer when rinsing dishes to catch food scraps.

Coconut Shack – Safety Instructions

Your safety is our top priority. Please review the following emergency instructions during your stay.

In the Event of a Fire

- There are three fire extinguishers available on the property:
- 1. Under the kitchen sink.
- 2. In the first closet located on the right when entering the hallway, co-located with the hot water heater.
- 3. Mounted to the side of the outdoor kitchen wall, to the left of the grill.
- Use a fire extinguisher only if it is safe to do so and you are comfortable using it.
- Always call 911 first in the event of a fire emergency.
- Evacuate the home immediately if the fire cannot be contained.

In the Event of a Water Leak

- To shut off the main water supply to the home:
- Locate the blue pot in the front parking lot.
- Lift the pot to access the water shut-off valve underneath.
- Turn the valve clockwise until it is fully closed.
- Contact us immediately to report any leaks or water-related issues.

Pool and Outdoor Safety

- Children ages 14 and under must be supervised by an adult at all times while using the pool.
- Please read and follow all posted pool rules, located on the fence near the pool area.
- Do not touch, climb, or play on the platform that houses the air conditioner, electrical panel, or pool pump.
- For everyone's safety, avoid running or rough play around the pool deck.

Whirlpool Dishwasher Instructions – Coconut Shack

Welcome to the Coconut Shack! Here's how to use the Whirlpool dishwasher with a START button.

1. Loading the Dishwasher

- Scrape off large food particles (no need to pre-rinse).
- Load plates, pots, and pans on the bottom rack.
- Place cups, glasses, and smaller items on the top rack.
- Load utensils handle-down in the silverware basket.
- Avoid blocking the spray arms.

2. Adding Detergent

- Open the detergent compartment (on the inside of the door).
- Add one dishwasher pod or fill with automatic dishwasher detergent.
- Do NOT use regular dish soap.
- Close the compartment lid until it clicks.

3. Starting the Cycle

- Close the dishwasher door securely.
- Press the desired wash cycle (Normal, Heavy, Quick, etc.).
- Press the START button once close door press START button again.
- The cycle will begin after a short delay.
- You may hear water flow and light humming this is normal.

4. After the Cycle

- Once the cycle ends, open the door carefully steam may release.
- Allow dishes to cool and dry slightly before unloading.
- Remove items from the bottom rack first to avoid drips from the top.

5. Helpful Tips

- Run the dishwasher only when it's full to save energy.
- Use 'Quick Wash' for lightly soiled dishes.
- If unsure, use the 'Normal' setting.
- For best drying, open the door slightly after the cycle ends.

FOOD TRUCK PARK & MARINA

Boaters entering Slipaway Marina from the Caloosahatchee River should navigate the channel at Red Marker 82 and Green Marker 83. Once in range, please hail us on Channel 16 (monitoring) and switch to Channel 12 (working). You may also contact the marina directly by phone at (239)-360-8883 for fueling, docking instructions, or general assistance. Upon approach, please slow to "Idle Speed/No Wake" within the marina basin for the safety of guests and fueling vessels. Dockhands will be available to assist during operating hours—please confirm when calling or hailing.

Vessels up to 40 feet in length, our slips vary from 8'4" – 12'9" beam (width). Our slips are designated for dock & dine access for paying customers only. Arriving and departing with the same passengers is required. Our docks are not to be used for guest pick-ups, drop-offs, or as a rendezvous point for transferring passengers. Overnight docking and pump-out services are not available. Boats that are docked overnight are subject to towing at the cost of the owner. Slipaway Marina is not responsible for overnight boat security, damages or theft.





BEACHES



Fort Myers Beach is an excellent spot for swimming and sunbathing, as well as water sports, like kayaking and parasailing. Travelers who head to the shoreline can expect wide swaths of clean, white sand as fine as powdered sugar, which is we I worth the journey for many. Rental shops for water sports equipment are positioned along the beachfront, and travelers can also reserve equipment ahead of time online through a company like Holiday Water Sports. Fishing enthusiasts can reel in their catches on the Fort Myers Beach Pier, which has an on-site bait shack and plenty of space to take a stroll and enjoy the views.



Sanibel's beaches are famous for their pristine sands and abundant shells. Due to the island's east-west orientation, Sanibel Island is the perfect site for the Gulf tides and over 250 types of shells. Breathtaking sunsets and playful dolphins contribute to the excitement of boating tours, and the beautiful waters of the island offer some of the finest fishing in the world. Other active ways of appreciating the plant, wildlife, and fish are to go biking, paddle boarding or kayaking.



One of the must-see animals for residents and visitors to Southwest Florida is the manatee and Lee County Manatee Park has a great viewing area for spotting them. There are a handful of observation decks to see the animals up close, but you can also hop into a kayak and paddle out to spot them. Recent visitors to the park say when it's cool out (and with a little patience) you can see upward of 50 manatees at the park.



Manasota Key, a hidden gem on Florida's Gulf Coast, offers visitors a tranquil escape with its untouched beauty and abundant wildlife. This barrier island boasts pristine, uncrowded beaches perfect for shelling, sunbathing, and swimming in the crystal-clear waters. Nature enthusiasts will enjoy exploring Stump Pass Beach State Park, where hiking trails wind through lush coastal vegetation, leading to secluded coves and panoramic views of the Gulf. With its serene atmosphere and breathtaking scenery, Manasota Key is a must-visit destination for those seeking a peaceful coastal retreat.
