North County Bus Stop Improvements

Estimated investment: \$2,855,260

This project will improve bus stops in the North County. The proposed improvements will include solar-powered bus stop shelters, benches, and trash receptacles. In addition, bus pads, bus turnouts with curb and gutter, ADA accessible curb ramps, and sidewalks will also be installed.



Acton Agua Dulce Shuttle Service Expansion

Estimated investment: \$1,277,000

This project will expand the days of operation for the Acton Agua Dulce Shuttle Service from three days to six days. The shuttle service provides a vital connection for Acton and Agua Dulce residents to the City of Santa Clarita and the Newhall Metrolink Station.

Antelope Valley Transit Authority (AVTA) Service Improvements/Transit Capital Jurisdictional Share

Estimated investment: \$2,745,500

The County will contribute Measure M funds towards the conversion of AVTA's fleet to an all-electric one. AVTA plans to be the first transit agency in the Country with a full fleet of electric buses by 2019.

Santa Clarita Transit Service Improvements/Transit Capital Jurisdictional Share

Estimated investment: \$2,745,500

The County will contribute Measure M funds to finance various service and capital improvements by City of Santa Clarita Transit.

Lake Los Angeles Pedestrian Plan Implementation (Phase 1)

Estimated investment: \$3,246,000

This project will install new sidewalks and Class I Bike Paths in the Lake Los Angeles community. These improvements were recommended in the Draft Lake Los Angeles Pedestrian Plan, based on input received from community members and stakeholders.

Elizabeth Lake Road Bikeways

Estimated investment: \$1,822,740

This project will install new bikeways along Elizabeth Lake Road between Lake Hughes Road and Johnson Road, and between Dianron Road and 10th Street West.
