Matthew 27:46 and Mark 15:34

Or was Jesus quoting the Psalms for the Sanhedrin, the chief priests and the scribes at the foot of the cross so that they would know in that moment that prophecy was being fulfilled before their eyes and that they indeed were crucifying the Son of God?

Psalm 22:1

My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?

Psalm 119 God's covenantal revelation, what God has appointed to be done. Christ was perfectly obedient to God, and through his Spirit we are transformed into his image and become obedient servants of God.

Isaiah 53 talks about God's plan for Christ and how pleased He was.

John 8:28 (the whole story is in 8:12-30)

So Jesus said to them, "When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am he, and that I do nothing on my own authority, but speak just as the Father taught me."

Mark 15:31

So also the chief priests with the scribes mocked him to one another, saying, "He saved others; he cannot save himself."

Ephesians 3:11 talks to Gods purpose for Jesus Christ being fulfilled. This was God's plan all along.

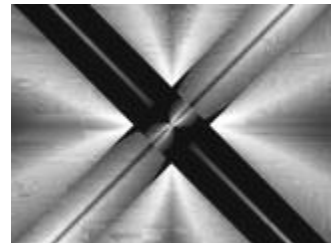
This was according to the eternal purpose that he has realized in Christ Jesus our Lord,
