<u>266</u>/hamartía ("sin, forfeiture because missing the mark") is the brand of sin that emphasizes its *self*-originated (*self*-empowered) nature – i.e. it is not originated or empowered by God (i.e. *not* of *faith*, His inworked persuasion, cf. Ro 14:23).
