ABOUT THE FACILITY



The Calsonic Arena is on The Celebration Showgrounds in Shelbyville, TN. Sitting on 105 acres, the 125,000 square foot coliseum has 150' x 300' main arena with an attached 125' x 250' enclosed warm-up area. The attached, covered Champions Arena is 150x300ft and there is also an outdoor ring located in the stable area. There are over over 40 recently updated shed row style barns, making up 900 permanent stalls. All stalls are 10' x 10' with a clay base, sliding doors, and accessible power and water. Also conveniently located in the barn area are wash racks and manure bins. There are 3 RV campground areas totaling nearly 300 spaces. Premium spaces offer 30 or 50 amp electric, water and sewer for \$55/night. Standard spaces offer 30 or 50 amp electric service with water and a dump station in that lot for \$48/night. Two bath houses in the campground area offer 15 mens showers and 15 womens showers.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **PAYMENT:** No entries will be accepted and no stalls reserved unless accompanied by payment in full of stall and entry fees. An open check or credit card number is acceptable. **Non-Stayed horses will be charged a \$25/day grounds fee.**
2. **REFUNDS:** In case of horses being entered and not exhibited, the office fees are not refundable, and stall fees are not refundable after the closing date unless they can be rented to someone else. Entry fees and exhibitor fees will be refunded.
3. **ENTRIES:** **Closing date for entries is June 5, 2020.** The word "Entry" will not be accepted. Each entry blank must contain the name and full description of each horse or pony and the class in which it is to be entered. Any entries not paid in full or received after the closing date, except stake and championship classes, will be considered Post Entries.
4. **POST ENTRIES:** Post entries will be accepted 24 hours before the session begins. Emergency Post Entries will be accepted in the Paddock at a \$25.00 additional charge per class.
5. **SCRATCHES:** All scratches must be made 2 hours prior to show time.
6. **DAMAGES:** All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agents to barns or other properties on the showgrounds, and will be charged accordingly.
7. **STALLS:** Stalls will be available from Monday, June 5 at 8:00am through Sunday, June 21st at Noon, at \$135.00 per stall. No stalls will be reserved unless accompanied by entries and payment in full for both stalls and entries. An open check or credit card is acceptable. There are 900 permanent stalls available and will be assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis with consideration given to previous attendance and sponsorship. No initial bedding will be supplied. Stable assignments are at the discretion of show management. Requests for specific stalls will be considered but not guaranteed. **Stall fees are non-refundable after the closing date of entries unless they can be rented to someone else.**
8. **BEDDING:** Bedding will be available at \$7.50/bag through the facility and ordered in the show office. Bedding will be pre-delivered if ordered in advance on the entry form. **NO OUTSIDE BEDDING DELIVERIES ALLOWED**, but you may haul in your own.
9. **HOLDS:** Holds must be requested at least one (1) hour in advance of each session. Holds will be limited to five (5) minutes. Emergency holds will be accepted by the Paddock Master.
10. **RULES:** Southern Saddlebred Spring Fling will be governed by Equine Sports Council. A copy of the most current rulebook is available at EquineSportsCouncil.org
11. **HORSES:** All horses must be serviceably sound. In case of suspected unsoundness, the judge may, if he so desires, have the horse examined by the show veterinarian, and his decision will be final. No Exhibitor may use a Veterinarian's Statement to contradict the judge's decision.
12. **CAVEATS:** The Show Management reserves the right to decline to receive any entry and to return any entry fee and/or stable fee before or during the show, without being liable for compensation. Three entries are necessary to fill a class unless otherwise specified, or the class may be declared void, at the option of the Committee. If the entries in two or more classes of the same division are not sufficient to fill, the committee reserves the right to combine the same into competition.

13. **LIABILITY:** Neither Southern Saddlebred Sales Inc., the Show Chairmen, Show Manager, the Calsonic Arena, Equine Sports Council, nor any volunteer or sponsor will be responsible for any accident which may occur to any owner, rider, driver, groom, attendant, animal, or equipment at the show. *Each rider exhibits at their own risk.*

WARNING: Under Tennessee Law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or death of a participant in equine activities, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated Title 44, Ch. 20, Part 1.

14. **SHOW RING:** No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except the exhibitors and those having official or requested duties to perform. No horse will be allowed in the show ring except at such hours as posted in the show office.

15. **DISCIPLINE:** Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judge or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, driver, or groom shall be grounds to disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees. In the case of any horse being disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize in that class shall take the prize that had been awarded to such disqualified horse.

16. **DISPUTES:** Should any question arise that is not provided for in these rules, the same shall be referred to the Show Manager/Chairmen and ESC Show Council whose decision shall be final.

17. **DRESS:** All riders, drivers, attendants, and grooms shall be neatly and appropriately dressed upon entering the ring.

18. **PETS:** Pets must remain on leash at all times and are the owner's responsibility.

19. **NEGATIVE COGGINS:** A valid negative Coggins test within one year of the show must accompany each horse and must be available for inspection.

20. **PARKING:** All trucks, vans, trailers, and RVs, after unloading, must park in the designated parking area.

21. **CHECKS:** All checks should be made payable to Southern Saddlebred. Returned checks will incur a \$50.00 handling fee. No one will be allowed to show who has a bad check or handling fee outstanding.

22. **RING PROCEDURES:** The gate to the show ring will remain open two minutes after the first horse enters the ring, after which the gate will be closed. Any exhibitor not in the ring by that time will not be admitted. Please cooperate by being on time. Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, the PA system and paddock calls over that system must be considered a courtesy. Therefore, no protest will be upheld, nor will any section be changed due to a PA malfunction.

23. **CAMPERS:** Premium Camper hookups are available for \$55 per night and Standard Camper hookups are \$48/night. Reservations will be accepted and you may pay via credit card or in the show office.

24. **GOLF CARTS:** Golf carts are to be operated only by a licensed driver.

25. **STABLE AREA:** Gas, electric or propane heaters, propane tanks and hot plates are prohibited in the stable area. All electrical extension cords must be 12 gauge, 3 wire and prong negative type.

26. **NO SMOKING IN ANY BUILDING, RESTROOM OR STABLE ON GROUNDS!**

27. **DECORATIONS:** All barns and stalls must be left the same way they were found. Any mulch, plants, decorative rocks, water fountains, etc, must be put on some type of removable plastic so the mulch is not left in the rocks, and must be removed or a \$250 fee will be assessed to the stall renter.

EQUINE Sports Council

Dear Friends,

In response to the industry's desire for an "alternative governing organization," Equine Sports Council was formed in 2019. We have spent the last year developing rules, standards and guidelines for Open/Unrated grassroots shows. ***Why is this important?*** A couple of reasons - but the first one being that we live in a very litigious society. Ten years ago every other television, radio and billboard ad wasn't for an accident or injury lawyer. Putting on a show with no rules, no standards, no dispute resolution process, and no one to back you up in the event of a problem is a frightening proposition.

As many of you know, Southern Saddlebred Sales, Inc was organized as an auction company 8 years ago, and has morphed into two horse shows annually. It's grown to the point that we realize we need governance, but we choose to not be USEF rated. I've been working with a group of people to create an alternative that we believe suits our show horse industry better. The rules "inside the ring" - class specs, judging standards, how the classes are run - are the same regardless of affiliation with any governing body. However the rules "outside the ring" - such as conduct/sportsmanship standards, officials roles and responsibilities, responsibilities of shows, horse and human welfare, and definitions (such as novice/limit/amateur/professional) are where horse shows need written, enforceable rules. ESC's rules are clear, simple, available online for your review at **EquineSportsCouncil.org**, and a hard copy will be in the show office.

ESC is funded by a \$15 per Performance Horse and \$5 per Academy Rider fee which constitutes a contract between the owner/exhibitor/trainer and ESC to follow these rules at this horse show. There is no membership requirement.

I hope that you will support this effort by Equine Sports Council to bring structure and knowledge to grassroots shows, providing an opportunity for those new to the industry to compete and learn in a constructive environment, while giving experienced exhibitors the confidence that shows in the ESC Network will be well run.
