Hortus Pink and sub-contractors will work with the clients and suppliers to adopt procedures that:

- Reduce waste where possible through reusing existing materials, recycling and reclamation.

- Actively avoid the use of plastic plants and lawns (astroturf) in projects and reduce the amount of plastic put into the ground.
- Seek to conserve water, flora and forna for the benefit of wildlife.
- Be aware of and aim to reduce the risk of contamination of pernicious weeds and other ground contaminants.
- Where possible increase the use of environmentally acceptable materials, products and equipment.
- Monitor to ensure that suppliers follow acceptable environmental policies.
- Actively promote environmental awareness among sub-contractors and clients.

Hortus Pink recognises that the overall responsibility of environmental sustainability rests with the owners and management, who will be accountable for the implementation of this policy.

These responsibilities include:

- Ensuring that where achievable all environmental policies and procedures are implemented.
- Begin to establish measurable objectives and targets to ensure continued improvement aimed at the elimination of waste, pollution and environmental harm.

• Encourage consultation and cooperation between owners, management, sub-contractors and stakeholders in matters which may affect or impact on the environment.

• Continually review this policy and aim to provide adequate resources to meet our environmental commitments.

Sub-contractors also have responsibilities, which include:

- To follow all environmental policies and procedures.
- Recognise and report hazards which may affect the health and well-being of the environment.
