

RULES OF CONDUCT FOR:
Coaches, players, fans, and officials

1. I will remember that the game is for children and not for adults.
2. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game and/or practice. The coaches control the athletes - not the parents.
3. I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my players ahead of any personal desire to win.
4. I will lead by example in demonstrating fair play and sportsmanship to all the players.
5. I will remember to treat each player as an individual, remembering the large spread of emotional and physical development.
6. I will do my very best to provide a safe playing situation for all my players and all involved.
7. I will provide support for coaches and of officials working with my child to provide a positive enjoyable experience for all. (Coaches have feelings, too!)
8. I will promise to help my child enjoy the youth sports experience within my personal constraints by assisting with coaches, being a respectful fan, providing transportation or whatever I am capable of doing. Parental support is great, but parental interference can be counter-productive.
9. There shall be NO use of profanity during games or practices by the coaches, referees, players, or fans.
10. Each organization should try to be considerate of other organizations, especially at away games.
11. Keep the goals of the program in mind. Let the children have fun.

IN SUMMARY: The coaches, referees, parents, fans and board members of each organization must always keep in mind the purpose of PEE WEE Football, which is to teach the kids the fundamentals of the game. Sometimes we place too much emphasis on winning instead of teaching kids to do their best.

If any of the above mentioned are violated, there will be a \$15 fine to that association to be paid to the league.
