They can change into their shirt at the start of class (or put it on over whatever other shirt they're wearing) and take it off after the photo.

Practice Records: Week 4

We are in Week 4 of our current Practice Record, which is due on Tuesday, February 25th.

As a reminder, I check everyone's Practice Record on Mondays. Students who have a parent/guardian signature and minutes written in can earn 2 Dawg Tags! I have many extra practice records, so your student may ask any time if they need a new practice record. Students must have all 5 signatures, minutes recorded for each week, their name, start date, due date, practice assignments written (on the back), and turned in on time in order to earn their 100 points. Remember—time spent playing their instrument outside of their class period (including practicing saying their note names and fingerings/studying their fingering chart) all counts as practice minutes. Please let me know if you have any questions about practice records.

Pueblo Spring Band Concert: Thursday, February 27th

Concert reminder letters will go out on Thursday, but here are the main details:

Binders Needed: Students need to have their music in a 3 ring binder in sheet protectors so their music doesn't blow away at the concert. This doesn't need to be a specific size or color, and they may use one from another class.

Concert Date: Thursday, February 27th in the Pueblo Amphitheater (it's in the center of campus outside the MPR)

Warm-Up: 5:30pm in the Pueblo Band Room for all students.

Concert Time: 6:00pm in the Pueblo Amphitheater

Concert Order: Jazz Band, 6th Grade Band, Concert Band, Symphonic Band

Students will sit with their families before and after their performance and stay for the entire concert.

What to Bring: Bring camping chairs, picnic blankets, beach towels, etc. for the audience. Feel free to bring a picnic dinner too! Our Band Boosters will be selling concessions before the concert and between groups as well! It will be a beautiful night!!!

Concert Dress: Same band concert uniform as the fall concert (band polos for 6th grade and Concert Band with black dress clothes; Symphonic Band in all black dress clothes with Pueblo ties for students who wear ties).

7th and 8th Grade Scale Tests Thursday

Thursday for the last two weeks of the quarter).

Each quarter we will be checking off 3 scales, and this quarter we are testing on concert G, D, and Gb major scales. Our first check-off day will be this Thursday, February 13th (Symphonic Band will have trumpets and low brass on Thursday, and horns/woodwinds/percussion will go on Friday). For this first day, all students will play in class for two required rounds and then an optional third round. Starting next week, students will be allowed to check off scales before school on non-Jazz Band days starting at 7:50 am (next Wednesday is a Jazz Band trip, so next Thursday the 20th will be the only before school opportunity that week; otherwise Monday, Wednesday, or

Our second check-off day will be next Thursday, February 20th, and our final check-off day will be on Tuesday, March 4th. Students may also check off scales before school this Thursday and Friday morning or next Monday, Wednesday, or Thursday morning in the band room starting at 7:50. Students will need to check off all scales by Friday, December 20th for their 100 points.

8th graders must play all three scales from memory for their 100 points. 7th graders (and new 8th graders) can earn extra credit for memorization, but it is not required. Both grades can earn extra credit for extra octaves, and 8th graders can earn extra credit for speed (120 bpm or above).

6th Grade Update: Band Karate

- We learned our first scale today! Concert Bb! It's always a rite of passage, and they did a great job!

- Students will earn a treat for each belt they complete and will earn one Dog Tag per song they complete.
