Save the Date: Pueblo Winter Band Concert December 18th at Desert Vista

Our Winter Band Concert was originally scheduled for December 17th at Corona. Due to the extension on the construction on Corona's auditorium (it's projected to be completed in January now), the concert has been moved to Wednesday, December 18th at Desert Vista High School. I passed out blue letters to the students in class two weeks ago and emailed it, so hopefully you have already put it on your calendar. Here are the details:

Concert Date: Wednesday, December 18th at Desert Vista High School

Warm-Up: 5:45pm in the Desert Vista Band Room

Concert: 6:30pm in the Desert Vista Auditorium

Concert Dress: Same band concert uniform as the fall concert plus optional holiday accessories (santa hat, elf ears, Hanukkah attire, holiday socks, holiday jewelry, etc)

Instrument Decorations: Students can dress up their instruments/mallets/drumsticks as long as the instruments still work, the decorations can be removed, and the instrument doesn't get damaged. Cookies: We will need people to donate cookies and other finger food type desserts for our annual Cookie Reception following the concert. We'll need help with collection and distribution as well, so be on the lookout for a Sign-Up Genius in December.

Extra Credit Concert November 26th: Tempe Winds: Time/Location Update

I have joined a new ensemble this year! It's called Tempe Winds and is conducted by Dr. Steve Meyer, the director of bands at NAU! The group has been around for a long time, but they've recently undergone some changes since their original director retired a few years ago. This is a smaller band with many fantastic professional musicians and educators, and I am playing in the clarinet section. They are working on an audition policy for the future, so we will be rotating on parts this season. We had our first rehearsal last week, and I can already tell it's going to be an amazing group!!!

Our first Tempe Winds concert is coming up next Tuesday, November 26th at 7:30pm. We just found out that the Tempe HS auditorium will be undergoing construction early, so we

are looking for an alternative location. I will send an email with that update as soon as I have that information.

Tickets are \$5 each and will be sold at the door. I will offer 100 points of extra credit for students who are able to attend (there's no school the next day, so no worries about being out late on a school night!). We are performing a wide variety of pieces including a salute to the armed forces, music from Porgy and Bess, John William's music from the movie Far and Away, Italian Rhapsody, and more!

For your planning purposes, we will also have concerts on January 28th (7:30pm) and April 19th (2:00pm).

Save the Date: Cookie Dough Delivery 12/5

Cooke dough orders will be delivered to Pueblo on Thursday, December 5th and may be picked up in the MPR from 3:00-4:30pm. They will be organized by the seller's last name. We will need parent volunteers to help with distribution, so please email me if you are available/interested.

Practice Records: Week 4

We are in Week 4 of our current Practice Record, which will be due on Tuesday, December 3rrd. As a reminder, I check everyone's Practice Record on Mondays. Students who have a parent/guardian signature and minutes written in can earn 2 Dawg Tags! I have many extra practice records, so your student may ask any time if they need a new practice record. Students must have all 5 signatures, minutes recorded for each week, their name, start date, due date, practice assignments written (on the back), and turned in on time in order to earn their 100 points. Remember-time spent playing their instrument outside of their class period (including practicing saying their note names and fingerings/studying their fingering chart) all counts as practice minutes. Please let me know if you have any questions about practice records.

7th and 8th Grade Scale Tests This Week

Each quarter we will be checking off 3 scales, and we will have our first check off day Next Thursday,

November 21st (Symphonic Band will be Thursday for most Brass and Percussion and Friday for the Horns and Woodwinds due to the size of the class). This quarter we will be testing on concert Ab, Db, and C maior scales.

8th graders must play all three from memory for their 100 points. 7th graders (and new 8th graders) can earn extra credit for memorization, but it is not required. Both grades can earn extra credit for extra octaves, and 8th graders can earn extra credit for speed (120 bpm or above).

Our second check-off day will be December 5th, and our final day will be December 12th. Students may also check off scales before school on Monday, Wednesday, or Thursday mornings in the band room starting at 7:50 starting the week of November 25th (they will do their first day of scale tests in class). Students will need to check off all scales by Friday, December 20th for their 100 points.

7th and 8th Grade All State Band Auditions due 12/6

This is a reminder that recordings will be due by Friday, December 6th. Recordings are to be audio only (except for percussion), and these need to be emailed to me (I will then upload them to the audition site). Students can record at home or at school. I will be checking in with the students to help with this process. I'm happy to help students with their audition music before school on any non-Jazz day (Monday, Wednesday, or Thursday).

6th Grade Update: Band Karate

- We will continue with Band Karate this week with Woodwinds on Thursday and Brass/Percussion on Friday.
- As stated in the directions, students may also email me videos to check off songs and/or check them off before school on Monday, Wednesday, or Thursday mornings (the band room opens at 7:50 each mornina).
- Students will earn a treat for each belt they complete and will earn one Dog Tag per song they complete.

Jazz Band Update

We will rehearse on both Tuesday and Friday this week. Please check your email for the Jazz Updates email I sent out earlier today with more details for Saturday as well as some new dates for the third quarter.

We only have 2 rehearsals left before our performance on Saturday and really need all students at these rehearsals. I know mornings can be ROUGH (my child is NOT a morning person, so I get it!), and I really appreciate your help with this!

The gate opens at 7:00 and closes at 7:05. • 2nd Quarter Jazz Band Performances:

- Our first performance of the year will be this Saturday, November 23rd at the Dayspring Holiday Boutique at Dayspring Church in Tempe!
 - We will meet in the warm-up room behind the performance area at 10:00am, and the performance will start at 10:30am. We will be done around 11:00am.
 - Thank you to everyone who has volunteered to move equipment! We will meet at Pueblo at 9:00am to load and will bring equipment back immediately following the performance.
 - Students will wear their Jazz Band shirts (they're being designed and will be here in time for the performance), nice jeans (as in no giant holes), and optional holiday accessories!
- We will also perform at Paloma, but we're still working on finalizing that date (that performance will take place before school for us, and students should be back in time for 1st period). We usually wear our Jazz Band shirts with holiday pajama pants for that performance, but I'll update you as it gets closer. We will need vehicles to help transport equipment for that as well, so be on the lookout for that once we have the date.

- Our final performance will be at the Pueblo Winter Pep Assembly on Friday, December 20th.

- We will perform at the annual Pueblo 5th Grade Showcase on Wednesday, January 22nd.
- Students need to be in the band room at 4:30pm for warm-up, and we will perform as part of the 5:00pm presentation. We will go back to the band room afterward to play while families are touring campus.
- I am still thinking about what to have them wear and will update you on that.

• Tucson Jazz Workshop Daytrip: February 19th

- I am thrilled to announce that we will be returning to Tucson this year! Unfortunately the Jazz festival date did not work with our calendar, so we will be going to Rincon/University High School to do a performance for the Rincon/University Jazz Band on Wednesday, February 19th! Their Jazz Band will perform for us as well, and we'll have a clinic with their amazing director, Mr. Jeff Marchant!!! They have one of the best Jazz Bands in the state, and this will be a fantastic opportunity!!!
- Here's a rough outline of the day: We will meet at 7:05am, leave at 7:30am (charter bus), do our performance/clinic, have lunch (probably U of A Student Union again), go to Reid Park Zoo, and head back to Pueblo with a return time of 5:00pm.
