# Pueblo Band Yearbook Pictures: February 13th

Please note that we will be having Pueblo Band yearbook photos on Thursday, February 13<sup>th</sup> during the school day. I will work out a schedule to have Concert Band and 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Band combine during one of those class periods for their photo.

Concert Band and 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Band students will need to wear or bring their Pueblo Band concert polo for the photo (no need for the black pants/shoes for the photos—whatever they want to wear for pant is fine).

Symphonic Band students will wear an all black shirt, but ties aren't required since we'll be taking the photo during their class period. They can change into their shirt at the start of class (or put it on over whatever other shirt they're wearing) and take it off after the photo.

### Practice Records: Week 2

We are in Week 2 of our current Practice Record, which is due on Tuesday, February 25<sup>th</sup>.

We had Practice Record #4 due last Tuesday. They are worth 60 points if students turn them in tomorrow (Tuesday) and 50 points if they turn them in on Wednesday.

As a reminder, I check everyone's Practice Record on Mondays. Students who have a parent/guardian signature and minutes written in can earn 2 Dawg Tags! I have many extra practice records, so your student may ask any time if they need a new practice record. Students must have all 5 signatures, minutes recorded for each week, their name, start date, due date, practice assignments written (on the back), and turned in on time in order to earn their 100 points. Remember—time spent playing their instrument outside of their class period (including practicing saying their note names and fingerings/studying their fingering chart) all counts as practice minutes. Please let me know if you have any questions about practice records.

**Concert Order:** Jazz Band, 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Band, Concert Band, Symphonic Band

Students will sit with their families before and after their performance and stay for the entire concert.

What to Bring: Bring camping chairs, picnic blankets, beach towels, etc. for the audience. Feel free to bring a picnic dinner too! Our Band Boosters will be selling concessions before the concert and between groups as well! It will be a beautiful night!!!

**Concert Dress:** Same band concert uniform as the fall concert (band polos for 6<sup>th</sup> grade and Concert Band with black dress clothes; Symphonic Band in

all black dress clothes with Pueblo ties for students who wear ties).
