#### **Practice Records: DUE TOMORROW**

Practice Records are due tomorrow (Wednesday) for 100 points (they must be filled out correctly with name, dates, minutes, and signatures on the front and their practice assignments written on the back). Students who have a parent/guardian signature and minutes written in can earn 2 Dawg Tags! I have many extra practice records, so your student may ask any time if they need a new practice record. Students must have all 5 signatures, minutes recorded for each week, their name, start date, due date, practice assignments written (on the back), and turned in on time in order to earn their 100 points. Remember—time spent playing their instrument outside of their class period (including practicing saying their note names and fingerings/studying their fingering chart) all counts as practice minutes.
