2020 Legacy Award

Judy Jaboolian Mongiardo, resident of Wellesley, Massachusetts, was honored this year by Family Promise Metrowest, a nonprofit which she helped to found to serve families facing homelessness in and around Boston, with the presentation of their 2020 Legacy Award. The organization's mission is to transform the lives of families with children that are without adequate housing by mobilizing a diverse community to provide shelter, education and comprehensive support.

Judy notes that this has been a labor of love for her, from planting the first seeds in 2003 as a member of Wellesley Congregational Church to create a network of interfaith congregations, to providing the foundation for an organization that is now a recognized leader in homelessness prevention and change.

This tribute to Judy was given by Director Sue Crossley:

"Judy has been part of Family Promise Metrowest as one of our founders, board members and

most recently as Network Coordinator until her retirement earlier this year. She has played every conceivable role in the history of Family Promise and her efforts will impact the future of our organization and the families it serves for generations to come."
