Soy City Indivisible will hold a sidewalk protest, in coordination with the weekend of action planned across the country, on January 11, 2026 from 2:00 pm to 3:30 pm at the corner of Eldorado and Franklin Street in Decatur.

Soy City Indivisible is a grassroots political action group here to exercise our 1st Amendment rights to address the government for our grievances.

Our government, through ICE under Noem's DHS, has killed at least 33 people since the beginning of the trump regime; they have detained at least 170 citizens as of last October; they have abused the right of due process regularly and with impunity. They have renditioned people to countries in which they have never been, exposing those people to human rights abuses in those countries' prisons. We stand fully opposed to spending our tax money on the terror, torture, and human rights abuses committed by this regime under the excuse of national security. We reject the lie proffered by the regime that Renee Nicole Good was a terrorist, but instead was a mother, a writer, a motorist, and a citizen who was murdered in cold blood by incompetent at best, malevolent at worst, "law enforcement" of ICE. We demand that the agency be stopped, defunded, and held accountable for the crimes it has committed against humanity and against the citizenry it is charged with protecting.
