Truman for shooting down 23 enemy (Japanese kamikaze) planes in a sustained, 90 minute attack, more planes shot down in a single engagement than any ship in the history of the US Navy, before or since), and a full Lieutenant in Korea, where he served two tours as the War Plans Officer on the staff of the Commanding Admiral, Seventh Fleet. He served his first tour on the Admiral's staff on the USS Missouri (Admiral's flagship) and the second tour aboard the USS New Jersey.
