The Board of Supervisors of Overfield Township, Wyoming County, Pa., met at 7:00 P.M at the Overfield Township Municipal Building for their second regular meeting for the fiscal year 2026.

Those present were; Vice Chairman-John Manglaviti; Roadmaster- John Walsh; Tunkhannock Police Chief-Ed Morristell; Alicia Tench- substitute Secretary and 2 residents. Chairman-Donald Ames and Sec/Treas-Susan Smith were absent.

The minutes of the January 5th meetings (reorganization & Regular) were not read as copies were e-mailed to all supervisors prior to the meeting. Mr. Walsh made a motion that the minutes be accepted as written. Mr. Manglaviti seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

Zoning report

Cody Stanco gave the Zoning report for February. There were two (2) permits issued; no (0) certificate of nonconformance; Mislevy- Zoning Hearing granted variance and LWMA variance was also granted by the Zoning Hearing Board. A motion was made by Mr. Manglaviti to accept the police report. Mr. Walsh seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

-Mislevy Zoning Hearing Decision- Mr. Walsh stated that Mislevy went through the process without a permit. He put the silo up and the Zoning Hearing Board approved the variance so a precedent was set to do what you want. But the cost of appeal is high and there is no guarantee that it would be overturned. Mr. Walsh made a motion to not appeal the decision. Mr. Manglaviti seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

-Patrick Rudisail – Shore Lane the beginning of the road used to be plowed. Last snow it was not plowed. The township did maintain the road before it was paved why not now? Mr. Walsh stated that the township will not plow now that there are speed bumps in.
