Those present were; Chairman-Donald Ames;; Roadmaster- John Walsh; Tunkhannock Police Chief-Ed Morristell; Secretary/Treasurer- Susan Smith; Auditor-David Kennedy and 2 residents. Vice Chairman-John Manglaviti was absent.
