The Board of Supervisors of Overfield Township, Wyoming County, PA., met at 7:00 P.M. at the Overfield Township Municipal Building for their eighth regular meeting for the fiscal year 2021.

Those presents were: Chairman-Donald Ames; Supervisor-John Manglaviti; Roadmaster-John Walsh; Sec./Treas.-Susan Smith and 3 signed in residents.

The minutes of the last meeting were not read but copies were e-mailed to the Supervisors. A motion was made by Mr. Manglaviti and seconded by Mr. Walsh to approve the minutes of the July 13th meeting. All in favor. Motion carried.

The bills were presented for review and discussion. A motion was made by Mr. Manglaviti and seconded by Mr. Walsh that the bills be paid. All in favor and the motion passed.

Solicitor's Report- none Police Report

Chief Ed Morristell gave the police report for the month of July. There were 50 incidents: 4 traffic citations, 1 traffic warning, and 2 criminal arrests with 9 charges. A motion was made by Mr. Manglaviti and seconded by Mr. Walsh to accept the report. All in favor. Motion carried.

Planning Commission Report

Chad Patton read the minutes from the Planning Commission meeting held in July. Mr. Ames made a motion that was seconded by Mr. Manglaviti to accept the minutes. All in favor. Motion carried.

Zoning Report

Chad Patton gave the zoning report for the month of July. There was one building permit. A motion was made by Mr. Walsh to accept the report and Mr. Manglaviti seconded it. Motion passed. Mr. Patton also gave updates on complaints he had received, variances that may be filed, and upcoming subdivisions. He also inquired about a website for the township and the need for a copier for the building which all the supervisors were in favor of. Mr. Patton stated that Art Russo was supposed to bring plans in for this meeting and there was no communication.

Road Report

Mr. Walsh read a summary of the road work done in July which included pipes cleaned on Point Road, shop clean up, maintenance on equipment, work done at the park, brush cutting, potholes filled, oil on dirt roads, signs erected, and calcium spread. A motion was made by Mr. Ames and seconded by Mr. Manglaviti to accept the road report. All in favor. Motion carried.
