Chief Ed Morristell gave the police report for the month of June. There were 48 incidents in the township. 5 traffic citations were issued, 2 traffic warnings and 1 arrest was made.

Road Report

Mr. Walsh read a summary of the road work done in June which included grading and laying calcium on Purdy, Freeman, and Mahon; pipes cleaned on Erhardt; shop cleanup; Maintenance on equipment; cold patch on Orchard, work done at the park (signs, brush cutting, weed spraying); brush cutting; stone on Pete Hill Road; potholes filled; oil on dirt roads and storm clean up. A motion was made by Mr. Ames and seconded by Mr. Manglaviti to accept the road report. All in favor. Motion carried.

Park Committee Report

Susan Smith spoke earlier with members of the park committee and stated that the park now has garbage cans, connected with the donators of the dog stations, the basketball court is going to be resurfaced, a grant application was submitted to Dicks for a basketball backboard and hoop and asked

that the tables be brought over so that they can be sealed. Mr. Manglaviti said for them to pick the color and his wife, Carol, will do the work.
