Chad Patton gave the zoning report for the month of May. There were 2 building permits and 1 septic permit issued. A motion was made by Mr. Walsh that the report be accepted. Mr. Manglaviti seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

Road Report:

Mr. Walsh gave a summary of the road work done in May: equipment maintenance and repair, grading, mowing and weed removal. A motion was made by Mr. Ames to accept the report. Mr. Manglaviti seconded the motion. All in favor. So carried.

Police Report

Chief Morristell gave the report for May: There were 24 incidents: 3 traffic citation, 0 traffic warnings, 0 criminal arrests, 6 hours vascar, 40 hours patrol and 35 hours for incidents. A motion was made by Mr. Manglaviti to accept the police report. Mr. Walsh seconded the motion. All in favor. So carried.

Park Committee Report

Paula Schloder and Christine Sheehan gave the park report: Grants were applied for and results are expected in January 2025; a check for \$100 is requested by Barry Isett; there was a \$2000 donation from the Factoryville Sportsman Club; Poppy's party has a 185 person cap which will have food and drinks, raffles, grazing table, desert table, games, and music; a gate is needed for the field and Trevor Brown has already raised money for it; Trevor will be doing a corn hole tournament at the Methodist Church; there was a clean up on May 19th and 25 people participated including Mr. Manglaviti; youth group will be doing a prayer walk and picnic . There was

discussion about where the new sign should be placed. A motion was made by Mr. Walsh to accept the Park Committee report. Mr. Manglaviti seconded the motion. All in favor. So carried.
