The Board of Supervisors of Overfield Township, Wyoming County, Pa., met at 7:00 P.M. at the Overfield Township Municipal Building for their sixth regular meeting for the fiscal year 2024.

Those present were; Chairman-Donald Ames; Supervisor- John Manglaviti ; Roadmaster- John Walsh; Zoning Officer- Chad Patton; Sec. / Treas. - Susan Smith; Police Chief- Ed Morristell; and 3 signed-in residents.

The minutes of the regular meeting of May 14<sup>th</sup> were not read as copies were e-mailed to all supervisors prior to the meeting. Mr. Manglaviti made a motion that the minutes be accepted as written. Mr. Walsh seconded the motion. All in favor. So carried

The bills were presented for review and discussion. A motion was made by Mr. Manglaviti that the bills be paid. This motion was seconded by Mr. Walsh. All in favor. So carried.

**Zoning report**

Chad Patton gave the zoning report for the month of May. There were 2 building permits and 1 septic permit issued. A motion was made by Mr. Walsh that the report be accepted. Mr. Manglaviti seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

**Road Report:**

Mr. Walsh gave a summary of the road work done in May: equipment maintenance and repair, grading, mowing and weed removal. A motion was made by Mr. Ames to accept the report. Mr. Manglaviti seconded the motion. All in favor. So carried.

**Police Report**

Chief Morristell gave the report for May: There were 24 incidents: 3 traffic citation, 0 traffic warnings, 0 criminal arrests, 6 hours vascar, 40 hours patrol and 35 hours for incidents. A motion was made by Mr. Manglaviti to accept the police report. Mr. Walsh seconded the motion. All in favor. So carried.

**Park Committee Report**

Paula Schloder and Christine Sheehan gave the park report: Grants were applied for and results are expected in January 2025; a check for \$100 is requested by Barry Isett; there was a \$2000 donation from the Factoryville Sportsman Club; Poppy's party has a 185 person cap which will have food and drinks, raffles, grazing table, desert table, games, and music; a gate is needed for the field and Trevor Brown has already raised money for it; Trevor will be doing a corn hole tournament at the Methodist Church; there was a clean up on May 19<sup>th</sup> and 25 people participated including Mr. Manglaviti; youth group will be doing a prayer walk and picnic . There was

discussion about where the new sign should be placed. A motion was made by Mr. Walsh to accept the Park Committee report. Mr. Manglaviti seconded the motion. All in favor. So carried.

-County Aid- A motion to offset the cost of the grader with the \$2,227.60 in county aid was made by Mr. Ames. Mr. Manglaviti seconded the motion. All in favor. So carried.

-Mr. Walsh explained the cost of calcium chloride vs AEP dust control. A motion was made by Mr. Ames to use calcium chloride instead of AEP. Mr. Manglaviti seconded the motion. So carried.
