

STATEMENT


"My work is based on the simplicity and beauty of the forms.

STATEMENT


"The protection of nature, its care and the love of the earth are the pillars under which Karin Barrera's work emerges. Of an emotive and spiritual connection, her work invites one to reflect on re-usage as a sustainable axis of the world.

This premise is applied to the themes she explores in her paintings, as well as the way in which her work is made up, by means of the use of recycled medical X-rays as a support to show her human figures, the feminine world, birds, trees, and above all, nature. Intense and striking colors emerge from her palette; nature greens, red tones as a symbol of her inner world, yellows, violets, and ochre tones. Every tonality is used to a greater or lesser degree according to the period her creatmagination is going through, always giving importance to the light opening up In forests, mountains and skies, a visual rainbow giving energetic life and choreography in each of her works."

BIOGRAPHY


Outstanding Chilean visual artist and cultural manager, with more than 20 years of national and international experience, has developed a high level of leadership and management capacity, opening herself up to the possibility of directing, coordinating, managing and helping Chilean artists and artists from Latin America. to internationalize their careers in the different art markets of the world. She began doing cultural management in Chile and then concentrated all her effort and profession in international events, highlighting the efforts she carried out in England at Herrick Gallery, 2019. She participates in the organization and exhibition at the World Art Dubai 2018 Art Fair. In 2019, he created South Trip Gallery, which, in 2020, became a Chilean creative industry company backed by Prochile as a "Country Brand" company. In 2019, as director and manager of South Trip Gallery, together with ambassador Jorge Daccarett and Prochile, she brings works of art by 43 artists to the Middle East. Organizes more than 80 artists for the Spectrum Miami Fair in 2019, coordinates the Chile Hall from 2014 to 2018, in the II, III and IV Biennial of Contemporary Art of Argentina (Borges Cultural Center), being in 2018 received with The entire group of artists by President Michelle Bachelet in the Azul room of the Palacio de la Moneda, a historical fact, since it is the first time that a president receives the group of 33 artists who that year are exhibiting in Argentina.

During 2017, she carried out an exhibition tour taking several Chilean artists to South Korea, and in 2019 she exhibited and organized a group of 8 artists at the Tadini Museum in Milan, Italy. In the year 2020, in full confinement, he shows a great level of adaptation and understands the need to combine technology with his management, therefore, he organizes more than 60 artists from South Trip Gallery in Alliance with Perseus Group on the online sales platform. Artsy and Alpha Art Design in NYC / Miami, Buy Art.Club in England. During the year 2021, she managed to manage more than 100 Chilean works of art in the Marketplace in the USA, selling recently.

During her career, she has performed eight individual and ten collective exhibitions, both in Chile and abroad, including New York, Caracas, London, Miami and Lima.

Marcela also has participated in art fairs in Shanghai, Miami, Dubai and shortly in Australia. Her works have also been part of national and international auctions.

In December 2013, the International Association of Art Critics in Chile recognized her work as one of the twelve artists of the year, thus participating in the 12 x 12 Exhibition, New Media. In 2015 she was awarded the Pablo Neruda Prize from the Brazilian Literarte Association together with Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile.

Her art pieces are part of national and international, private and governmental art collections. Among these, thirty-four works that are part of the permanent collection of the corporate building of the Comptroller General of the Republic of Chile stands out. Currently, her work can be appreciated in important virtual media such as Arsty New York, Art Plus Shanghai, Spectrum Miami, Saatchi Gallery, Syngulart and South Trip Gallery.




