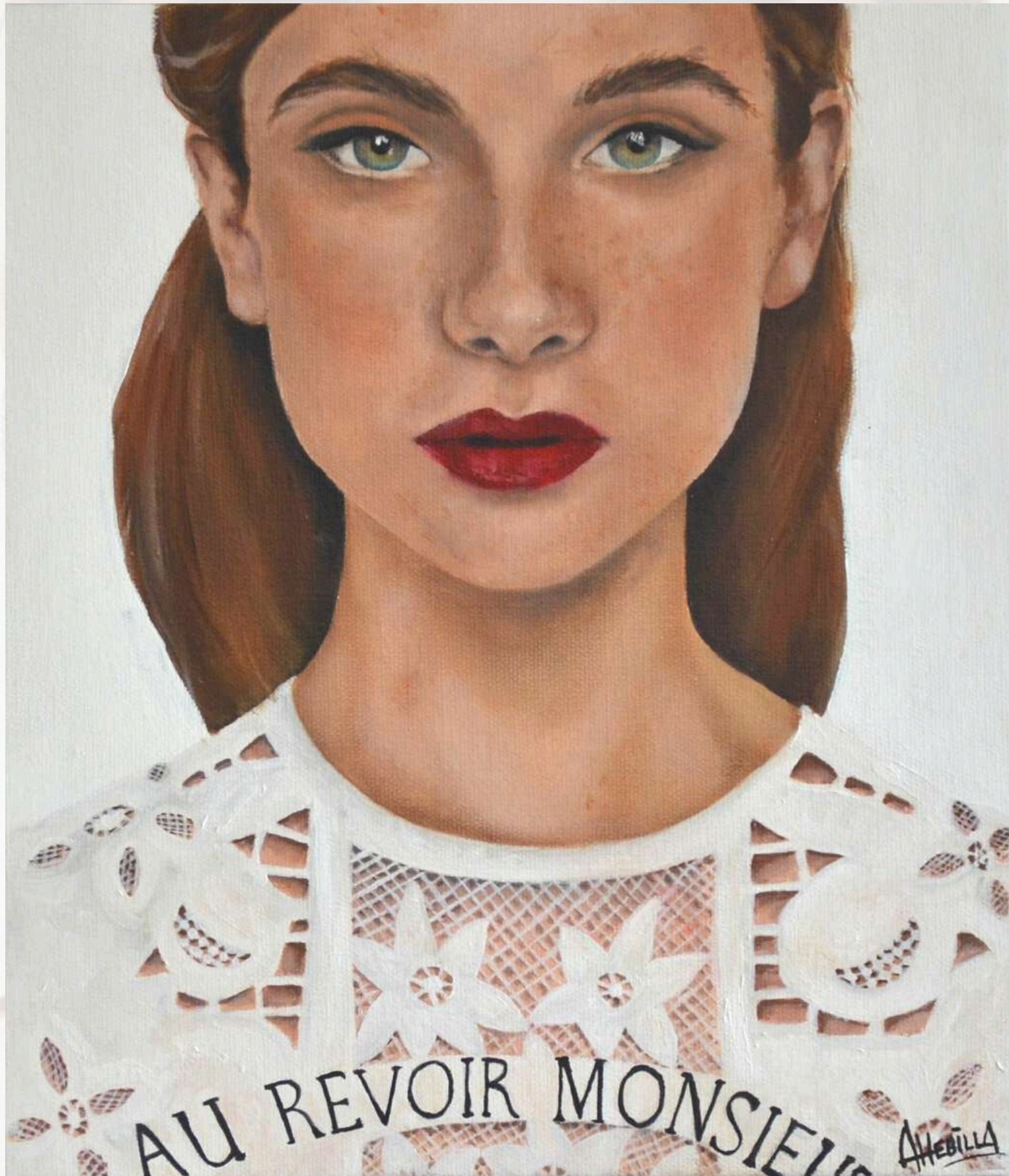

His painting is in private National and international Collection. This year his program includes new exhibitions in the United States and Europe.



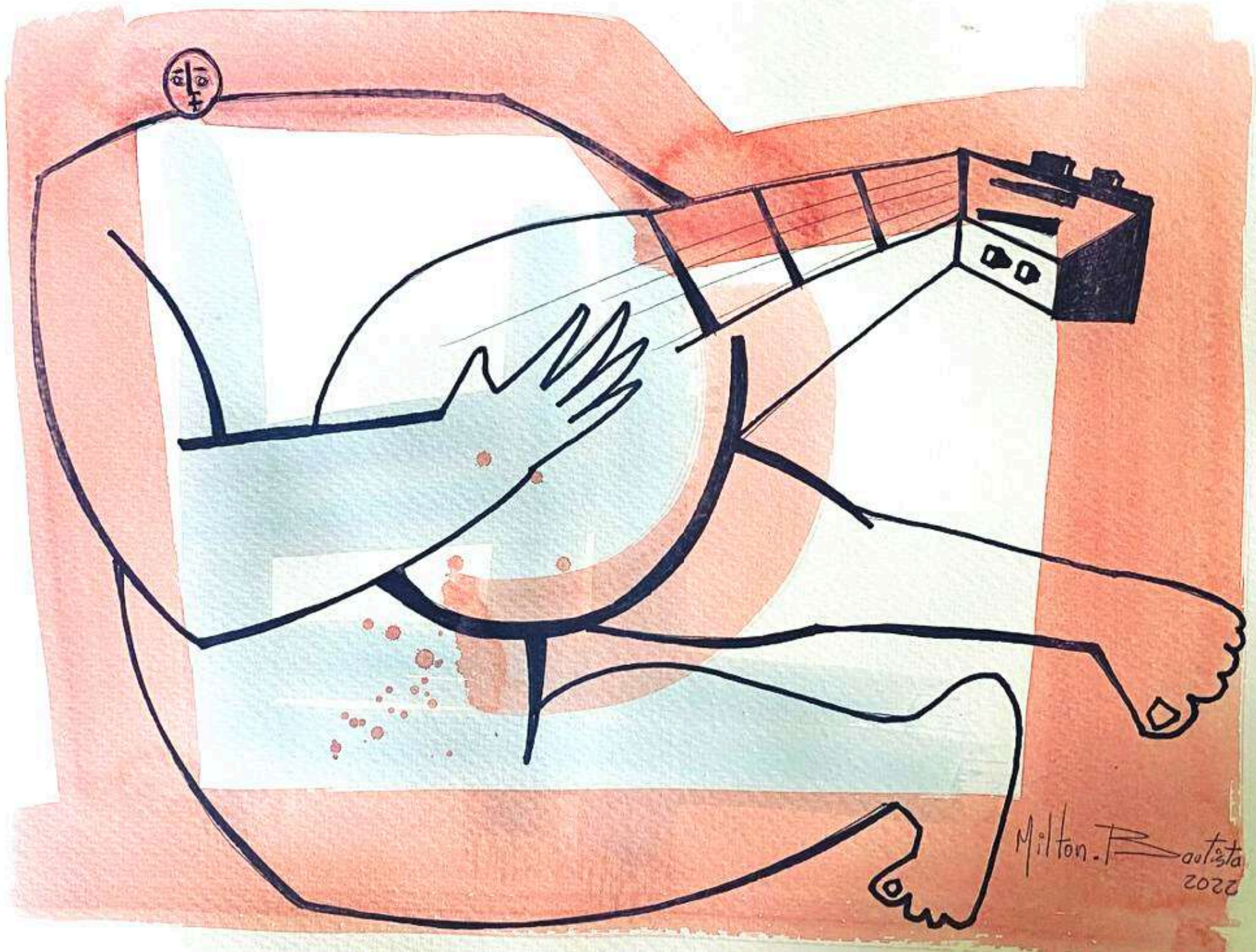

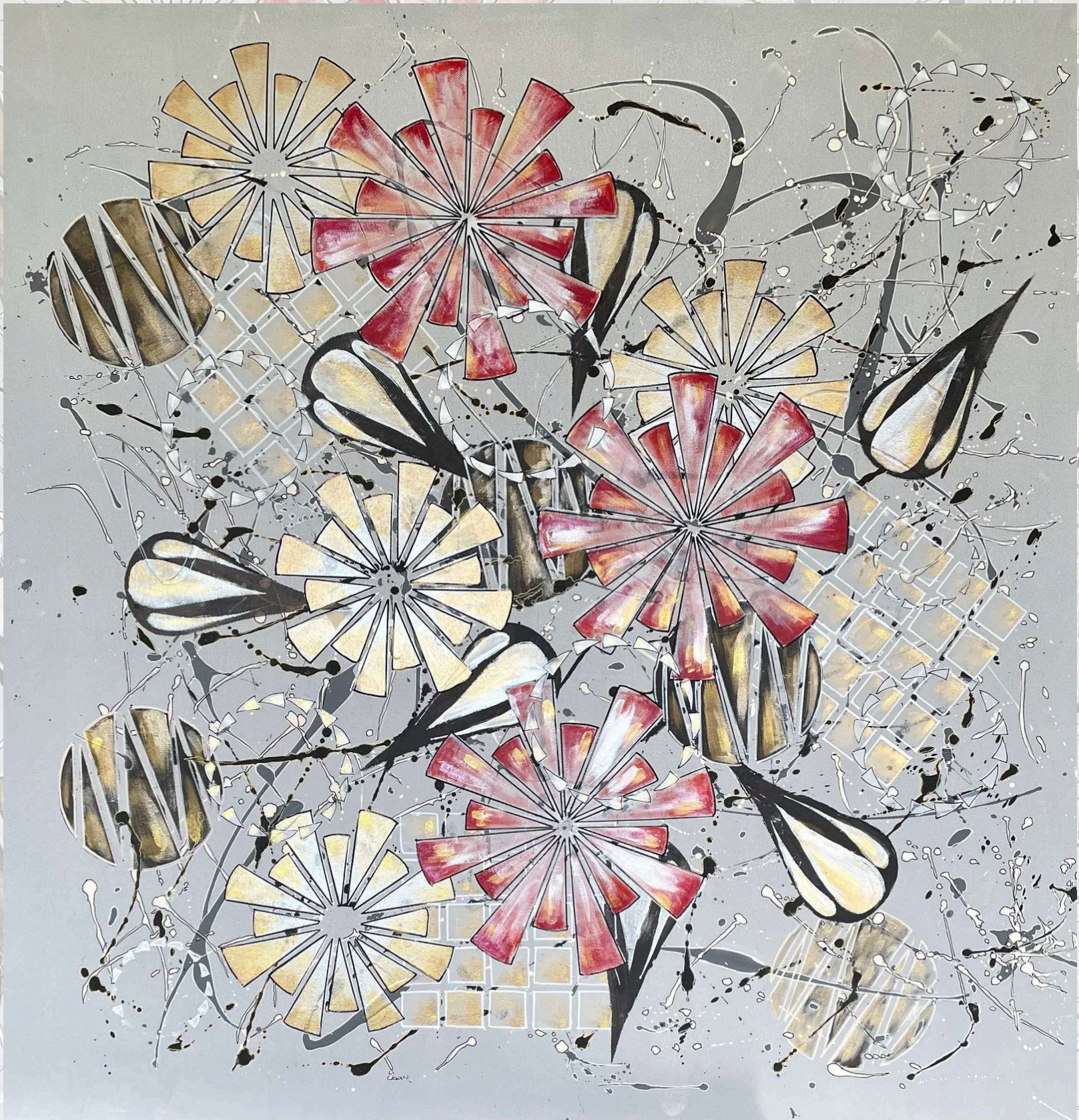


Born in 1974 in Santiago Chile, and currently based in the South of Chile, in the beautiful resort lake town of Frutillar.
