

## WOYSA Soccer By-Laws

Our goal is to give each child the ability to play, learn, & have fun. We believe in family friendly competition because competition brings out the best in everyone and teaches everyone to try hard and give their best. We hope everyone can be as proud to be a part of WOYSA as we are to keep this facility running for everyone to enjoy year after year and to be a place the children can look back upon fondly when they grow up. We hope everyone has a great season this year and for many years to come.

WOYSA would like to thank everyone that have decided to be a part of our facility. Thanks to all the work our referees put in to make our games run smooth. A special thanks to our coaches who dedicate their time to the children to teach them not only about sport but about teamwork and sportsmanship. Thanks to all the parents that sign their children up to join WOYSA.

## General Rules

#### **Uniforms:**

All players must wear the appropriate uniform to play. No hoodies or sweaters over jersey. No baseball/softball cleats. Shin guards are to be worn at all times.

No earrings, rings, watches, hair pins, hats, or wrist bands are allowed to be worn on the field. Soccer cleats must be worn by all 6U-16U players. Absolutely NO JEWELRY can be worn during games. A player wearing jewelry will be asked to remove the jewelry. If they are unable or unwilling to remove the jewelry, they will be removed from the game and unable to play until the jewelry is removed.

#### Age is determined by birth year, not age when season begins.

#### Playing Advantage: (8U-16U)

In 8U, a team can only play advantage if in a scoring position, so a possible goal isn't stopped. If a foul or handball is committed midfield, then call the foul and stop the play.

#### Substitutions: (10U-16U)

Players can sub in when there is a normal stoppage of play of their team's possession. Coaches must let the referee know they intend to sub. The player can not enter the field until the ref waves them on and all subs must enter at the center line. The team doing a corner kick, goal kick or throw-in can substitute freely. The opposing team can only substitute if the team with possession subs first.

## General Rules

#### Hand Balls:

#### 6U & 8U

Hand balls can be called if a child is purposely slapping at the ball or picking the ball up. No hand ball should be called if a ball is kicked in the air and a player tries to protect their face. Same applies to throw ins towards a player's face.

#### 10U-16U

Hand balls can be called if a child is purposely slapping at the ball or picking the ball up. The hand to ball, ball to hand rule applies. If a ball is kicked into a player's arm or hand that is in a natural position no hand ball should be called. If the ball hits a hand or arm in an unnatural position or moving toward the ball that is a hand ball.

# Handballs are at the discretion of the referee and will not be overturned.

#### **Penalty Shootout**

Coaches must select 5 players that were on the field at the end of regulation. The goalie must also have been the goalie at end of regulation. If still tied after first round of penalties, we then go to Golden Goal. The coach must select 5 different players for the second round. If the team doesn't have enough remaining players, the coach can then use whoever from the first-round. Those who haven't kicked yet must kick before any from the first-round kick again.

## General Rules

#### Cards

- Yellow cards are issued at referee discretion for fouls.
   Yellow cards can be issued to coaches for continuous arguing or questioning of referee.
- Red cards can be issued to players for cussing and slide tackles. Red cards can be issued to coaches for continuous arguing or questioning of referee after being issued a yellow card. Coaches can be red carded for not controlling unruly parents after being warned.
- If a coach comes on the field during for a reason other than a player injury, the coach will immediately be yellow carded. If the coach does not leave the field when yellow carded, the coach will receive a red card and must leave the facility.
- Parents can be yellow or red carded for continuous arguing or questioning of referee. They may also be carded if the come onto the field for any reason other than a player injury. We recommend that coaches handle injuries to ensure the flow of the game continues.

## Referees

#### **Requirements:**

All Referees are responsible to have their own whistle and yellow referee shirt.

A Game Bag will be checked out from the board room which will contain a game ball, scorecard, card book, and goalie pennies. Please make sure that your ball is aired up and all contents are in your bag before leaving the board room.

#### **Expectations:**

All Referees are expected to wear black bottoms and their yellow referee shirt. No oversized jogging pants or short shorts will be allowed. Referees are required to have closed-toe shoes, but tennis shoes/cleats are preferred. Layers should be added underneath your referee shirt, except in the case of rain.

#### Time:

Referees will not be paid if their scorecard is not submitted correctly. A correct scorecard consists of:

- Both teams' names/colors
- Referee's Name
- Score kept with player's number that scored indicated on score card. (for each goal)
- Clearly identified goals scored per half
- Total goals scored noted/circled

## Referees

#### **Referee Authority:**

We at WOYSA are making an effort to better control the actions of coaches and parents. Referees at WOYSA are given the authority to remove a parent if need be. No parent should argue or question a referee's call. Coaches can question a call as long as it is not conducted in a disrespectful manner or becomes a continuous issue.

If a referee hears a parent cussing or saying anything disrespectful or discouraging to a player, the referee will let the coach know what's going on and who it is and give them a warning. Coaches are responsible for the actions of their parents. To avoid referee to parent conflicts the coach is the one to be warned. It is then the coach's responsibility to deal with the parent. If the problem continues a red card is to be issued to the coach and the coach and parent are to leave the field. If they will not leave a board member should be notified and they will either remove them or call the law.

## Referees

#### Calls:

All calls are at the referee's discretion and are final. In games of two or more referees every call by any referee must be enforced. Referees should work together and respect each others calls.

#### Time:

Time keeping is up to the discretion of the head referee of the game. Please make substitutions as quickly as possible. Referee's will either stop their watch for long stoppages of play or add stoppage time to the end of the quarter or half.

#### **Penalty Shootouts:**

There must be 2 referees present for penalty shootouts. If 2 are not available a soccer board member can take the place.

## Coaches

#### **New Coaches:**

If you are new to coaching, we have some experienced coaches that can help. Contact a board member and they can arrange a time to pair up with an experienced coach and help you set up practices, run drills, teach formation, and teach rules of the game.

#### **Practices**

We require coaches 8U-16U to have at least 1 practice a week for at least 1 hour. We require Minis and 6U coaches to have at least 1 practice a week for at least 40 minutes. **Teams may not practice more than 3 times a week and no longer than 2 hours at each session**.

#### **Playing Time:**

#### We want all kids to have the same amount of playing time.

We require at least 20 minutes of play in 8U, 25 minutes in 10U & 30 minutes in 13U/16U. All players must play 50% of the game. It is at the coach's discretion to cut playing time for disciplinary reasons. A child **should not** be penalized for missing practice, though, as they are not responsible for their own transportation or may be a multi-sport athlete. If a coach is caught not playing a player the specified amount of time, they will be subject to disciplinary actions by the board.

#### **Jerseys**

We will allow coaches and parents to put kids' names on the back of their jerseys at their own expense. We ask that if you decide to do this, that every kid gets their name on their jersey and not one or a few. This is a team sport, and we want all teams to be uniform.

## Coaches

#### **Schedules:**

When the schedule is set the dates are **final**. No games can be rescheduled, except for rain outs. When a rain out date is set that date is final. We encourage every team to have an assistant coach or a parent that can step in and coach if the head coach can not make the game. If a team can not play on a set date, they will be forced to forfeit the game. If forced to forfeit a game the team will automatically lose any tie breaker scenario. If a team is short on players, the coaches can agree to play less players on the field or use a player from a lower age group to play up by parent's approval.

A game will not be delayed due to waiting on a single player.

## Coaches

#### **Scorecards**

When you sign the scorecard at the end of the game then the game is final. If there are any issues with the game do not sign the card and speak to your commissioner or the board **immediately**. Do NOT wait until the next day to speak to one of us. Nothing can be changed once the scorecard is signed by both coaches **OR** the game day has ended.

#### **Tournament:**

Tournament brackets are decided by standings at the end of the regular season. If all teams play the same teams the same number of times the tie breaker order is: Head-to-Head record – Goal Differencial - Goals For – Goals Against – Coin Flip. If we have uneven teams then the order will be: Head-to-Head record - Head-to-Head goal differential - Coin Flip

#### **Conflicts**

To avoid parent conflicts, we are asking coaches to help us by taking responsibility of the parents on your team. If you are having issues with a parent, the WOYSA boardroom is always open for anyone. If you would like to talk about an issue let us know and we will notify you of when our weekly board meeting will be held. Any issue from parent, player, commissioner, or other coach we will be happy to discuss and solve the problem. Also, we are always open to ideas or issues you may have with the facility. WOYSA has an open-door policy to anyone that is willing to come to come to one of our weekly meetings.

### **Parents**

#### **Facility Rules**

We ask all parents to please refrain from cussing, saying discouraging things, or yelling at referees. Parents should never say anything to a referee. We do not want to take away the excitement from the game we just ask parents to be respectful and courteous to the ones around them.

- No food or drinks are allowed to be carried into the facility.
- No pets allowed inside facility.
- No parents are allowed near the sideline. Coaches are the only people allowed on sideline.
- No parents allowed to stand behind or near the goals during a game.
- No smoking/vaping on the fields. You can go to the parking lot.

#### Fees: \$125 New Player \$75 Returning Player (spring only)

The registration fee covers your child to play in the regular season. A gate fee will be charged for tournaments. Coaches, players, & children get in free for tournaments.

#### **Uniforms:**

Uniforms that are bought for the fall season are also used for the spring season. If you need a new uniform, you will be charged the full price in the spring. (\$125) If the team you were on does not return for the spring you will get a new uniform for your new team.

## Draft and Tryouts

#### **Draft/Tryouts:**

Players will no longer be able to request a team for 8U - 16U. If a coach is moving to another division, he/she will only be able to bring their own child and any assistant coach. (Only 1 assistant coach's child will be guaranteed to be on that team.) Any player moving up a division will be required to try out and be selected during the draft. If a player does not show up for tryouts, that child is blindly drafted by the coaches after all children who were present for tryouts have been chosen.

#### Special Circumstances:

Siblings can be placed on the same team together. Both siblings will be required to tryout, but the siblings will go as a group to the coach that chooses either player. Other extenuating circumstances may be decided and voted on by the board on a case-by-case scenario.

WOYSA has an open-door policy, and we encourage anyone with an issue to please contact one of the board members. Anyone is welcome to come to a weekly board meeting and express your concerns there or ask any questions

Please keep in mind that all age groups, roster sizes, field sizes etc. are all subject to change depending on our enrollment numbers, number of teams, number of volunteers and weather/field conditions.
