



## MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE CODE OF CONDUCT

- We will foster the health and wellbeing of residents and promote a unified community showing support, mutual respect and friendship for each other.
- We will not seek to police the behaviour of residents against various regulations, rules or conventions. Nor will we attempt to take any form of disciplinary action against perceived or alleged non-compliance.
- As we represent all residents we will not get involved in disputes between individuals or groups of individuals.
- We will mutually support each other, rendering assistance and providing advice to fellow committee members where it is both sought and appropriate.
- Even when we do not agree, we will always listen to, consider and respect the views of others.
- We will respect and abide with decisions taken jointly in committee, and with those taken by members at a general meeting, even if we personally disagree with that decision.
- We will always fully consult on matters affecting the community to achieve consensus, especially those of a potentially sensitive nature, and will not take action (unilateral or otherwise) without such consultation and consensus.
- Although normally operating in an open and transparent manner, we will respect committee confidentially when dealing with sensitive or contentious issues.
