MINUTES OF THE JULY 25, 2018 REGULAR BOARD MEETING

Authority Board Meeting

1:00 P.M.

CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL: Chairman Stoneburner called the meeting to order at 1:00 P.M. Commissioners present were Jimmy Stoneburner, Wes Kahler, Lysanne Harma and Gary Moore. None absent. Also present were Executive Director John Crumb, Deputy Director Rich Pierson, Executive Assistant Anne Richmond, Charleston Township Supervisor Jerry VanderRoest, Engineer Paul Schram, and Augusta Village Manager Jeffrey Heppler.

REVIEW AND SET THE AGENDA: Crumb noted two adjustments to the Agenda: the Village of Augusta/Ross Twp Sewer Request discussion was moved to the beginning of New Business and Commercial Review was deferred to the August 22, 2018 Board Meeting. Harma made the motion to accept the Agenda as revised. Motion was seconded by Kahler. **Motion carried; all ayes.**

MINUTES OF THE JUNE 20, 2018 REGULAR MEETING: Page 6 of the meeting minutes was corrected to state that the Kalamazoo County Road Commission, not Richland Township, has an initiative to share information to foster better coordination of sewer, road, and Consumers Energy replacements. A motion was made by Kahler and seconded by Moore to accept the corrected regular meeting minutes of June 20, 2018 as presented. Motion carried; all ayes.

HEAR THOSE PRESENT (Non-Agenda Items): None Present

CORRESPONDENCE:

4766 EGLD Inquiry on "Red" Emergency Truck
Crumb fielded a phone call from a homeowner concerned about a red "emergency" truck with a white "W" on the door. Crumb explained that our engineering firm was doing some site investigation for future capital improvements in the area.

9126 E DE Ave Sewer Connection Fee Determination of \$3,250 The Sewer Benefit Fee for 9126 E DE Avenue was determined to be \$3,250 since it was originally part of parcel 3903-23-301-010.

604 Sunset View Concern Regarding Strong Sewer Odor from Pumping Station GLSWA received a call from the homeowner at 604 Sunsetview regarding a strong sewer smell coming from our pumping station. We responded by changing the charcoal filter and putting a rubber mat over the opening.

8845 Tamarisk Circle Inquiry on Email Bills
Crumb let a customer know that GLSWA does offer its customers the option to receive their utility bill via email.

Request for Single Inspection Fee for 5-day Project
The sewer connection to 8807 Gull Road may require multiple sewer inspections as
the sewer work for each day would be covered at the end of each day due to safety
concerns. GLSWA would only charge a single sewer inspection fee.

37th and Sherman Lake 2018 Grinder Pump Overview and Information The Grinder Pumps Overview and Information document was updated for 2018 and posted on our website. We are in the process of reviewing and updating our website.

Assistance Provided to Address Parking within ROW GLSWA fielded a concern from the owners at 462 EGLD regarding a new parking space across the road from their driveway. Crumb contacted the Kalamazoo County Road Commission to inquire if this is a No Parking area and if this new parking situation impedes the county ROW. Moore has also contacted the Road Commission and they are working on getting the new parking space removed.

34th St PPP Site Timeline and Updates for Purgewell Pumping Crumb reviewed a handout with various communications regarding the PFOS discharge at the PPP purgewells. Crumb will provide further updates as they are available.

NEW BUSINESS / PROJECTS UPDATE

MDOT Authorization of Performance Resolution for Governmental Agencies Crumb recommended approval of the Performance Resolution for Governmental Agencies. This will allow GLSWA and its contractors to work in the state highway right of way. A motion was made by Harma to adopt the Performance Resolution for Governmental Agencies. Motion was seconded by Kahler. Motion carried; all ayes. Crumb to complete Performance Resolution for Governmental Agencies and return to Paul Schram for submission to MDOT.

8870 Sturtevant Failed Sewer Line-Approve Sharing of Cost
Damage to a sewer line resulted in a sewer backup at 8870 Sturtevant. GLSWA was
not notified of the backup until the repairs were being completed. The failure appears
to be the result of an ATT cable going through the 6" sewer lead approximately 10
years ago. Utility Contracting Company proposed splitting the cost of the

repairs/cleanup with GLSWA since Utility Contracting's contract contained only a 7 year liability/damage clause. The cost of the repairs/cleanup is \$3,195. A motion was made by Moore to approve splitting the cost of the \$3,195 sewer repair/cleanup cost at 8870 Sturtevant with Utility Contracting Company. Motion was seconded by Stoneburner. Motion carried; all ayes. Richmond to issue \$3,195 check to the homeowner and invoice Utility Contracting Company for \$1,597.50. Crumb to evaluate if the cable may have pierced additional sewer leads for neighboring properties.

To Do List-Updated/Prioritized Review Transitional Master List / Old Business Pierson and Crumb reviewed and discussed the Master List of Old Business Items to be completed or initiated. The list is prioritized based by date. During the Charleston Township Sewer Expansion discussion, Supervisor Jerry VanderRoest asked if GLSWA would be interested in becoming the water operator for the Andrews Mobile Home Park. *Crumb will evaluate this and review any proposals with the Board*. The Kellogg Biological Station 40th Street School Sewer Project may not be happening.

Village of Augusta/Ross Twp 2 Ross Twp Residents Requesting Sewer (2) Ross Township residents have requested sewer adjacent to the Village of Augusta. The "Sewer Flow Through Agreement" of 2007 provided for the Authority to connect to the Village "System", subject to engineering submittal to Augusta. This agreement is not valid since the funding for the Hillcrest Development was never procured. Crumb & Pierson to propose new agreement with Augusta. GLSWA has requested Wightman to propose a reasonable district and a cost estimate. Crumb to provide district and cost information to Augusta.

Augusta Sewer Flow Thru Agmt Approved but Project Never Constructed Pierson and Crumb reviewed the liability of the pump station repair with Rob Thall. Crumb & Pierson to propose new agreement with Augusta.

Commercial Review Update Commercial Account REUs with Water Meter Data To be reviewed at the August 22, 2018 Meeting.

Policy Review-8205 N. 32nd St Credit Card Policy of \$1,000 Max Transaction Crumb informed the Board that a customer had paid a sewer bill over \$1,000 by paying it in (3) separate transactions. No action will be taken at this time.

9638 WGLD-Ritz Sewer Relocation with Easement Changes Mrs. Ritz indicates their project will not be ready to move forward this fall.

Gull Lake Ministries Preliminary Calculation Shows 15-25 Credits Crumb and Pierson to review with Rob Thall and make recommendation at next meeting.

Indian / Pickerel O&M Proposal In Draft Form Crumb is developing the draft proposal which will be reviewed with Rob Thall and presented at the next meeting.
