The proposed Nioka Solar Project is located on Glenrowan West Road, approximately 10km south-west of the town of Glenrowan. The project is landowner-led, with a potential capacity of up to 250 MW.

The project requires assessment through a Planning Permit Application under the *Planning and Environment Act 1987* and is in an early planning stage, meaning project details are still being developed and refined, and community feedback will help inform the design and assessment process.
