


Grassland Sedge

Unlimited uses! So adaptable and versatile, Grassland sedge (previously known as Berkley Sedge) always looks lush & pretty thriving in both sun and shade. Tough & carefree, use it to edge beds and paths or as a lawn Substitute. Even in quite shady areas under trees – it is unfazed by root competition or dog paws. Fills out to a dense 1.5'x1.5' clump that can be clipped or mowed. **Drought tolerant, deer resistant**, not fussy about soil. Can naturalize in moist, boggy, clay or sandy soils. Heat and humidity tolerant. Evergreen. Clumping. Small “flower or seed” stalks in late spring, after which it can be mowed if need be.
