

Dwarf Barbados Cherry

Malpighia glabra 'Nana'



A unique, tough, & colorful **native** shrub with clusters of small pink & white flowers spring, summer, & fall. Then, after each bloom cycle, producing an abundance of red cherry-like fruit. Puts on an unbelievable show of color in the fall! Tiny foliage, tight, compact rounded growth habit, & drought tolerant once established. Averages 3'-4' tall. Sun, light shade. Wildlife & bird food. Evergreen in milder winters. Normally root hardy.
